

Work continuing at Medlow Bath from 1 April

Medlow Bath Upgrade
April 2025



Transport for NSW pays respect to the Darug and Gundungurra people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respects to Elders past and present.

Work is progressing on the Medlow Bath Upgrade with the project on track to be completed in late 2025.

What work are we doing?

Great Western Highway and Bellevue Crescent:

- switching traffic onto the westbound lanes of the Highway
- carrying out general earthworks, pavement and drainage works, and landscaping
- constructing the shared path and driveways
- moving barriers and linemarking to realign traffic
- utility work including water, sewer, stormwater and streetlighting
- moving traffic back to the original intersection at Bellevue Crescent and the Highway with full access in and out.
- retaining wall works on the westbound lane east of Bellevue Crescent
- removing the pedestrian refuge island.

Railway Parade:

- landscaping
- fencing around the sediment basin.

Station Upgrade works:

- opening the new pedestrian bridge, platform stairs and lift for station access in early in April
- fencing off the pedestrian level crossing once the new bridge and lifts are open, and permanently removing it over the weekend of 31 May – 1 June.

We will share separate community notifications about the pedestrian bridge and level crossing changes.



When we'll be working

We will be working from **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday** and **Saturday from 8am to 1pm**.

We expect to carry out **nightwork** for up to six shifts in April, weather permitting. **Nightwork hours will be between 6pm and 7am on weekdays only.**

We will notify affected residents with dates, details of work locations, activities and likely impacts when they are confirmed,

Our work program is weather-dependent and will be amended as needed.

Bus stop locations

The temporary eastbound bus stop on the Highway will continue to be in place during April at the U-turn Bay on Railway Parade.

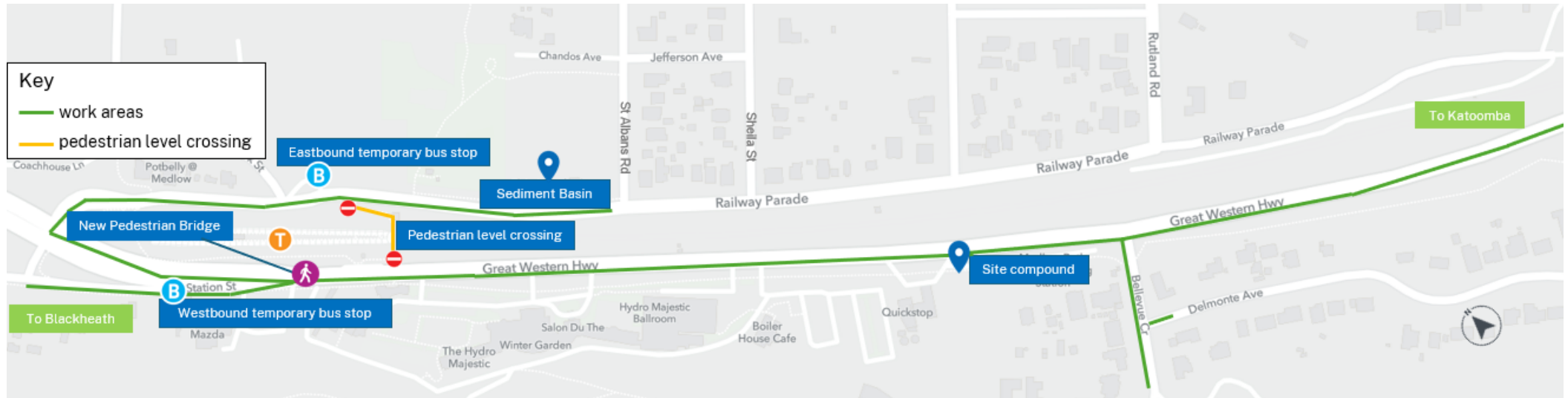
The temporary westbound bus stop will remain in its location during April as shown in the map over the page.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community, residents and the environment. This includes

- maintaining pedestrian and property access,
- turning off machinery,
- installing noise blankets,
- liaising with affected residents
- offering alternative accommodation where triggered.

Traffic control will be in place including stop/slow operations and a reduced speed limit of 40 km/h in some areas.

Road users and pedestrians are advised to follow the directions of signs and traffic control.
