


Work continuing at Medlow Bath from Saturday 1 March

Medlow Bath Upgrade February 2025







Transport for NSW pays respect to the Darug and Gundungurra people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respects to Elders past and present.

Work is progressing on the Medlow Bath Upgrade with the project on track to be finished in mid 2025.

When and where we'll be working

Work taking place across the project site is weather dependent and we have been amending our program accordingly.

Great Western Highway and Bellevue Crescent:

- switching traffic onto the westbound lanes of the Highway
- general earthworks, pavement, drainage, and landscaping work
- constructing the shared path and driveways
- moving barriers and linemarking to realign traffic
- utility work including water, sewer, stormwater
- installing underground cables for the new traffic signals

Railway Parade:

- · verge earthworks and landscaping
- constructing the sediment basin.

Station Upgrade works:

 constructing the pedestrian bridge, stairs, lifts and station services.

We will be working from 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and Saturday from 8am to 1pm.

Weather continues to impact our work program and we expect to carry out **nightwork** for up to six shifts in March, weather permitting.

Nightwork hours will be between 6pm and 7am on weekdays only.

We will notify affected residents with dates when they are confirmed, details of work locations, activities and likely impacts.

Bus stop location changes

The temporary eastbound bus stop on the Highway will continue to be in place at the U-turn Bay on Railway Parade until mid-April.

The temporary westbound bus stop will remain in its location as shown in the map over the page.

Bellevue Crescent temporary access


The temporary Bellevue Crescent intersection will remain in position until late March, as work continues on the new signalised intersection on the Great Western Highway. We will maintain right turns in and out at this temporary intersection while it is in place.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community, residents and the environment. This includes

- maintaining pedestrian and property access,
- turning off machinery.
- installing noise blankets,
- liaising with affected residents
- offering alternative accommodation where triggered.





Traffic Impacts

A temporary intersection, with full access in and out of Bellevue Crescent will remain in place.

Traffic control will be in place including stop/slow operations and a reduced speed limit of 40 km/h in some areas.

Road users and pedestrians are advised to follow the directions of signs and traffic control.
