

# Paint scrape trial at Meadowbank Bridge, Meadowbank and Rhodes

## Meadowbank Bridge Remediation

December 2024



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Wallumedegal Clan of the Dharug nation and Wangal people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW will repair and upgrade the heritage-listed Meadowbank Bridge to maintain this key pedestrian and cyclist corridor across the Parramatta River.

Transport is planning the restoration and improvement of the Meadowbank Bridge. As part of this process, Transport will take paint scrapes from the walls and pylons at each end of Meadowbank Bridge to understand what paint has previously been used on the bridge and to confirm the material of the pylons.

This will be done to understand the type of sealer and anti-graffiti coating will best protect the walls and pylons of the bridge.

### What work we'll be doing

Work will include:

- Setting up a work zone at both ends of the bridge
- Using hand tools or chemical stripper to remove and record one layer of paint at a time.

Pedestrians and cyclists will be able to use the bridge during this work.

### Where and when we'll be working

Work will take place at both ends of Meadowbank Bridge, at the pylons near Bowden Street, Meadowbank and Blaxland Road, Rhodes.

Work will take up to two weeks between **Monday 9 December to Friday 20 December**.

Working hours are **7am to 3pm, Monday to Friday**. There will be no weekend or after-hours work.

### What this will mean for you

Access to the bridge will be maintained throughout the works.

You may notice:

- Tape that fences off the work area
- Workers scraping paint or using chemicals to remove paint from sections of the bridge
- Low level noise from using hand tools.

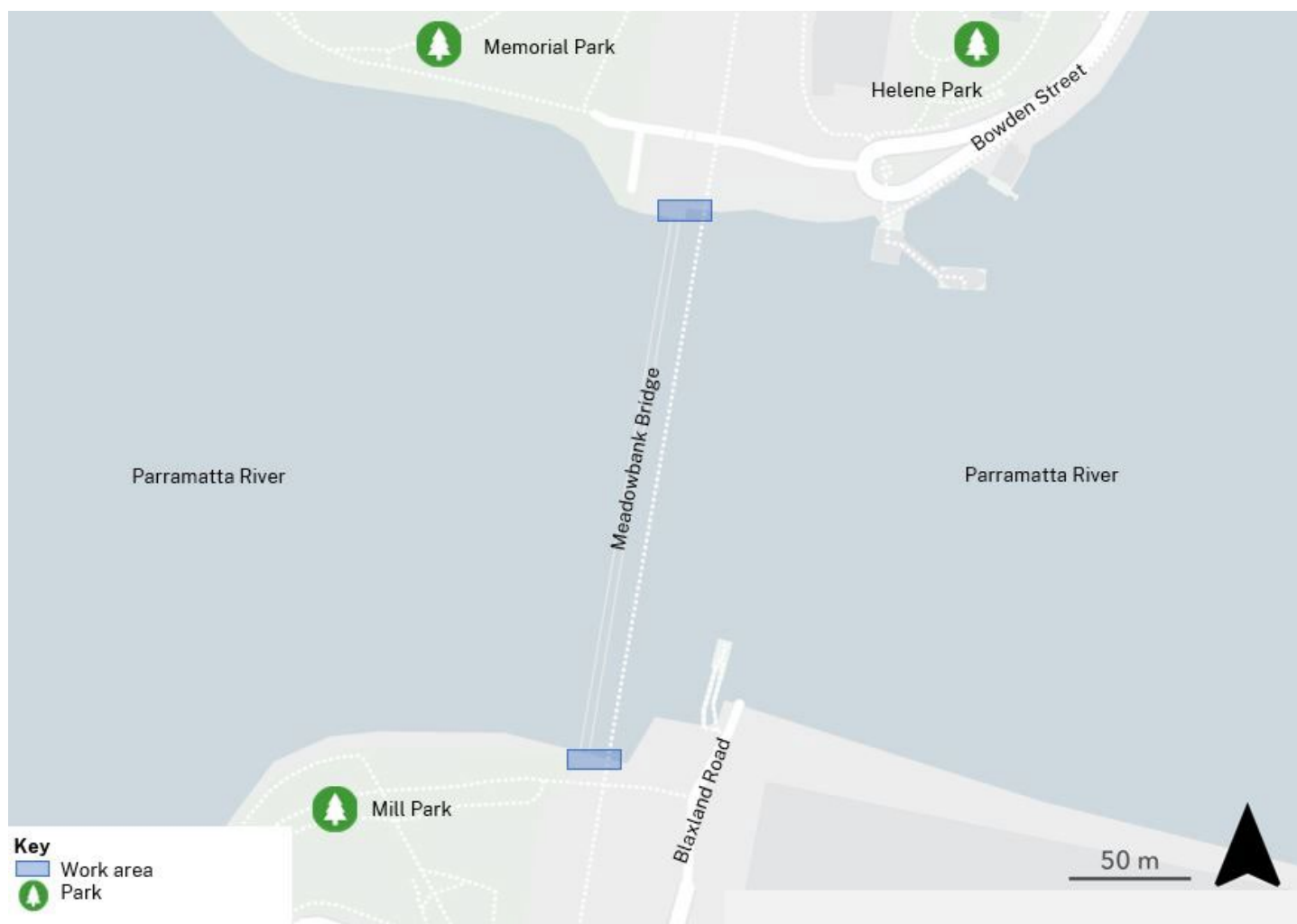
### Managing the effects of this work
