Work is progressing on the Medlow Bath Upgrade.

What work are we doing?

Great Western Highway and Bellevue Crescent:

- carrying out general earthworks, pavement and drainage works, including asphalt
- constructing permanent concrete barriers
- installing road furniture
- moving barriers and line marking to realign traffic between the intersection of Railway Parade and the Pedestrian bridge
- constructing the shared path and driveways
- relocating the Telstra phone box
- landscaping
- utility work including water, sewer, stormwater and streetlighting
- asphaltting and constructing kerb and guttering in Bellevue Crescent

Railway Parade:

- landscaping opposite the train station
- asphaltting at the intersection of Railway Parade and the Great Western Highway.

Bus stop locations

There will be no changes to the current bus stop arrangements in July. Bus stops will be in the locations shown on the map.

When we'll be working

We will be working from **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday** and **Saturday from 8am to 1pm**.

We expect to carry out **nightwork** for up to six shifts in July, weather permitting. **Nightwork hours will be between 6pm and 7am, Monday to Thursday night.**

We will notify affected residents with dates, details of work locations, activities and likely impacts when they are confirmed.

Vibration

We would like to thank the community for their patience while we completed the heavy roller works over the last few months.

We have completed most of the work requiring heavy rolling. We now only expect to use the rollers for some minor works that should be less impactful.

Managing our impacts

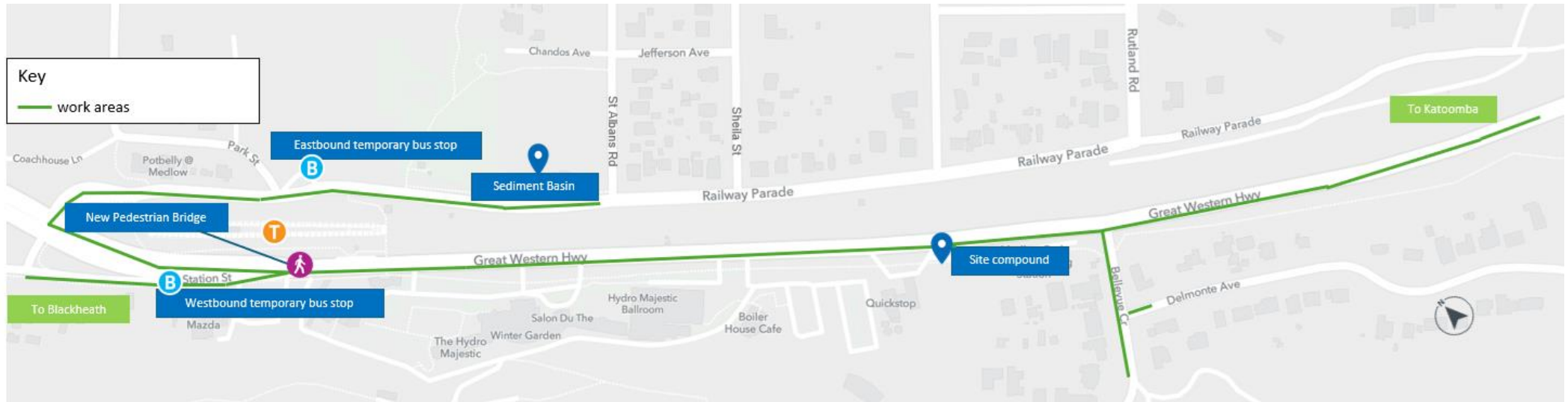
We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community, residents and the environment. This includes

- installing noise blankets
- liaising with affected residents
- offering alternative accommodation where triggered.
