


Work continuing at Medlow Bath from 2 June

Medlow Bath Upgrade June 2025







Transport for NSW pays respect to the Darug and Gundungurra people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respects to Elders past and present.

Work is progressing on the Medlow Bath Upgrade with the project on track to be completed in late 2025.

What work are we doing?

Great Western Highway and Bellevue Crescent:

- carrying out general earthworks, pavement and drainage works
- using a vibratory roller for pavement works
- constructing permanent concrete barrier
- moving barriers and line marking to realign traffic between the intersection of Railway Parade and the Pedestrian bridge
- · constructing the shared path and driveways
- relocating the Telstra phone box
- minor landscaping works
- · adjusting fencing along the retaining wall

Station Upgrade work:

 removing the pedestrian level crossing on 31 May and 1 June.

When we'll be working

We will be working from 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and Saturday from 8am to 1pm.

We expect to carry out **nightwork** for up to six shifts in June, weather permitting. **Nightwork hours will be between 6pm and 7am, Monday to Thursday night.**

We will notify affected residents with dates, details of work locations, activities and likely impacts when they are confirmed.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

 vibratory rollers will be used on and off during this period, causing vibrations that may be felt.

Bus stop locations

The temporary eastbound bus stop on the Highway will continue to be in place at the U-turn Bay on Railway Parade throughout June (see over).

The temporary westbound bus stop will remain in its location during June (see over).

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community, residents and the environment. This includes


- maintaining pedestrian and property access
- turning off machinery when not in use
- installing noise blankets
- liaising with affected residents
- offering alternative accommodation where triggered by environmental requirements.

The Great Western Highway will remain open while we work. For the safety of workers and road users, there will be some temporary traffic changes including traffic control, lane closures, and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h in some areas.
