

Macquarie Fields Station Upgrade – Community Notification

Transport for NSW is upgrading Macquarie Fields Station to improve accessibility, convenience and safety.

What work are we doing this month?

Work includes:

- Continuing concrete work for the new footbridge, stairs, retaining walls and ramp
- Installing new station services, such as telecommunications lines and electrical cables
- Building the foundations for the new station canopies
- Civil work at the station entrance

When and where we'll be working

We'll be working on Railway Parade, in and around Macquarie Fields Station, and within our site compound.

In October, standard construction hours are 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturday.

Out-of-hours work

We'll be working from **6am until 6pm on Saturday 11 October** during planned trackwork on the freight line, when freight trains will not be running.

Directly impacted residents will be contacted and advised of the likely impact and what we are doing to minimise disruption.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- Concrete trucks and pumps entering and exiting the worksites.
- Mobile cranes and delivery trucks to lift materials in and out of the worksites.
- Platforms at Macquarie Fields Station are narrow at some points due to the establishment of work zones behind timber hoardings.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to minimise impacts to the community by:

- Reducing noise as much as possible by turning off equipment when not in use and using nontonal reversing beepers.
- Providing traffic controllers or signage to direct pedestrians.
