

Changed traffic conditions at two locations on the Mid-Western Highway between Bathurst and Blayney from Monday 27 October

Transport for NSW is carrying out essential maintenance work at two locations on Mid-Western Highway to provide a stronger, longer lasting and safer road.

What work are we doing?

The work will include gravel patching to repair damaged road surfaces and pavement.

When and where we'll be working

We will be working at two locations along the Mid-Western Highway between Bathurst and Blayney:

- For approximately two kilometres from the Bathampton Road intersection, travelling towards Bathurst
- For approximately three kilometres from the Hen and Chicken Lane intersection, travelling towards Blayney.

We have included a map over the page to show the location of works.

Works will be carried out between **7am and 6pm, Monday to Friday, from Monday 27 October.**

We expect to complete the work in **five weeks**, weather permitting.

We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside of these hours.

What will this mean for you?

Work will be completed in stages to minimise disruption to road users.

You may notice:

- Noise from machinery and equipment
- Traffic control and signage in place
- Single lane closures and reduced speed limits.

Traffic impacts

For the safety of workers and motorists, a number of traffic changes will be in place:

- Reduced speed limit to 40 km/h
- Single lane closures
- Intermittent stopping.

Please allow an extra **five minutes** of travel time during these works.

Reduced speed limits will also be in place outside of work hours while these works are underway.

All road users are advised to follow the directions of signs and traffic control and slow down on approach.

Managing our impacts

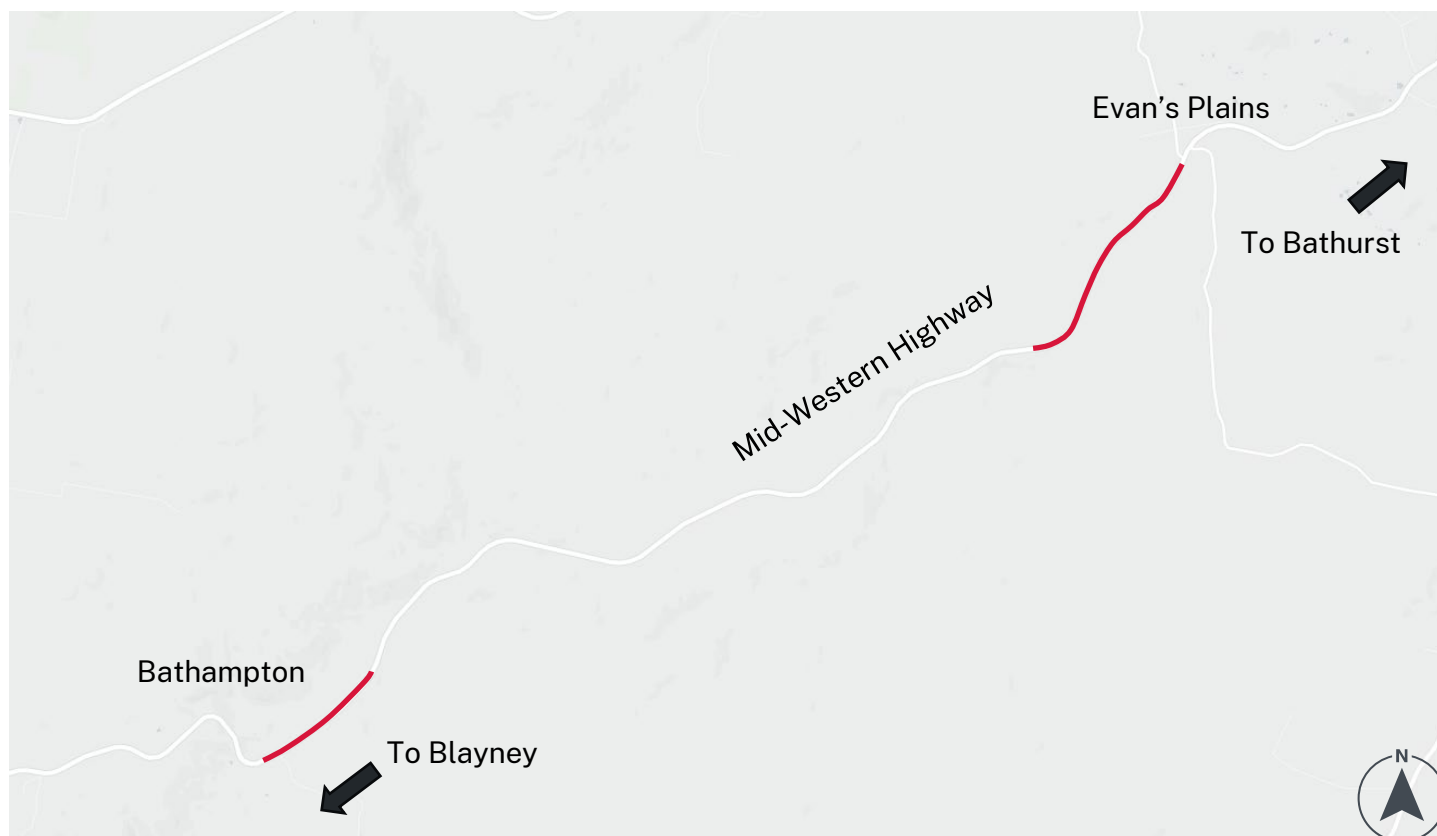
We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.
