Transport for NSW will carry out road resurfacing work on Moss Vale Road following recent landslip repairs to improve safety.

What work are we doing?

We'll be resurfacing sections near recent landslip repair sites, along with some nearby sections of the road requiring maintenance.

Work includes removing the current road surface, applying a new asphalt road surface and painting line marking.

When and where we'll be working

We'll be working at night between **7pm and 5am from Sunday 14 to Thursday 18 September 2025**, weather permitting. Line marking will be completed within two weeks of the resurfacing work and will also be completed at night.

We'll begin work from the top of hairpin near Cambewarra Lookout Road and continue down towards Barfield Road.

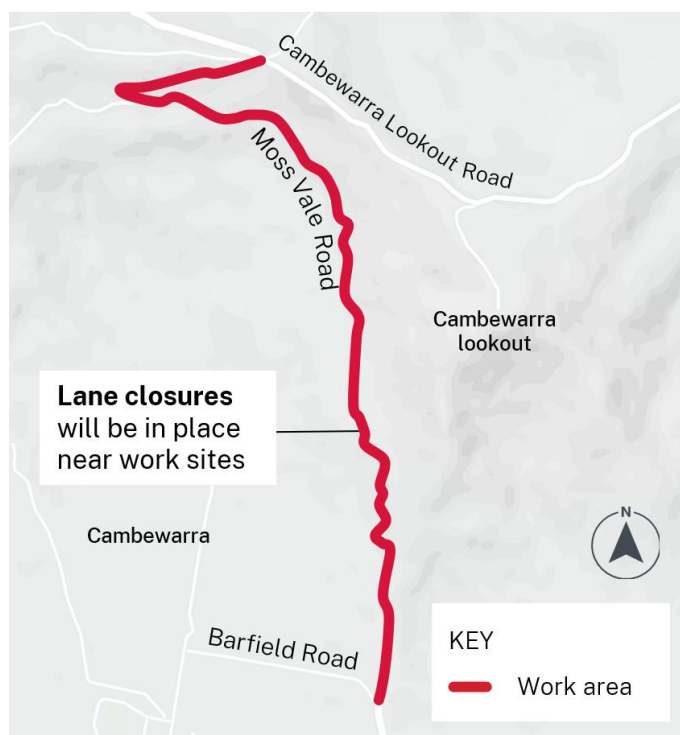
What will this mean for you?

During work hours, we'll be using machinery and equipment that generates noise, light and vibrations.

Nearby residents may experience some noise impacts from this work. We'll make every effort to minimise our impacts and complete this work as quickly as possible.

Road users will experience short delays, with one lane closed during work hours. Road users are advised to allow an additional 5 to 10 minutes travel time.
