

Moss Vale Station and Stabling Yard Upgrade

Community notification

April 2025





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

The NSW Government is delivering an upgrade to Moss Vale Station and Stabling Yard to achieve Disability Standards for Accessible Public Transport 2002 (DSAPT) compliance and to accommodate the new Regional Rail fleet.

The project will provide a station precinct that is accessible to those with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage, while aligning with Moss Vale's transport needs.

What work are we doing?

Construction continues in and around the station, stabling yard and on Lackey Road and Dalys Way, along with work on the Argyle Street footbridge and lifts.

Work in the coming month includes:

- preparing for the mid-April opening of Argyle Street footbridge and two new lifts. Work will continue in these areas until complete
- finalising landscaping work in the courtyard
- asphalt finishing and installing tactiles on Platform 2
- installing new automated doors for the waiting room, luggage room and station office
- opening the full waiting room for use
- landscaping on Dalys Way
- deck replacing on Lackey Road footbridge

 continuing work on the stabling yard and noise wall, which may increase heavy vehicle traffic in the area.

What does this mean for you?

Once the Argyle Street footbridge opens, access to the station will be through the passageway behind the station building where the waiting room is located.


The Lackey Road footbridge will close soon after the Argyle Street footbridge and lifts open.

The Station Master's office will be closed until mid-May. During this period, access will be through the door adjacent to the station entrance.

More workers will be present in and around the station buildings, and some areas may need to be temporarily isolated during work hours for safety.

When will we be working?

Most work will take place during standard construction hours of **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm Saturdays**.

Out-of-hours work

Work will take place between 6am Saturday 3 May and 6pm Sunday 4 May, and 6am to 6pm Saturday 12 April, during scheduled trackwork periods while the station is closed and no trains are running.

There will be no vehicle or pedestrian access along Dalys Way at these times. All buses will arrive and depart on Argyle Street near Leighton Gardens.

Lackey Road footbridge closure

To facilitate accessibility upgrades to the Lackey Road footbridge and Dalys Way, the footbridge will be closed for around two months from Tuesday 29 April, weather permitting.

The Argyle Street footbridge will be **open** before the Lackey Road footbridge and Dalys Way

Following this time, the station will only be accessible via the Argyle Street footbridge and lifts.
