

# Night work on 11, 12, 14, 18 and 19 August 2025

## Mulgoa Road upgrade

August 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Darug people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is continuing work on Mulgoa Road between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road.

### What work are we doing?

We will be working on Mulgoa Road at the corner of side streets, and the M4 ramps. The map on the next page shows the work locations.

Work includes:

- investigating, removing, building and maintaining road surfaces
- investigating, installing and switching over to newly installed utilities and drainage

- median work at Glenbrook Street and Peter Court intersection
- removing and installing barriers on the eastern side of Mulgoa Road
- restoring site when work is finished.

The stockpile site at 95 Blaikie Road will be used during this work.

Night work is scheduled on Monday 11, Tuesday 12, Thursday 14, Monday 18 and Tuesday 19 August between **6pm and 7am**.

In case of bad weather or operational issues, we will work on 13 August, 15 August and 20 August 2025.



## Traffic changes

The **M4 eastbound entry ramp** from Mulgoa Road to the M4 travelling towards the city will be closed on the **above nights between 8pm and 5am, except on Thursdays when the closure will take place between 9pm and 5am**. Please detour via The Northern Road or use the M4 westbound entry ramp to travel to Russell Street and access the ramp to the M4 travelling towards the city.

The left turn slip lane from the southbound lanes of Mulgoa Road into Blaikie Road (east) is closed. Blaikie Road (east) can be accessed by turning left at the traffic lights on Mulgoa Road.

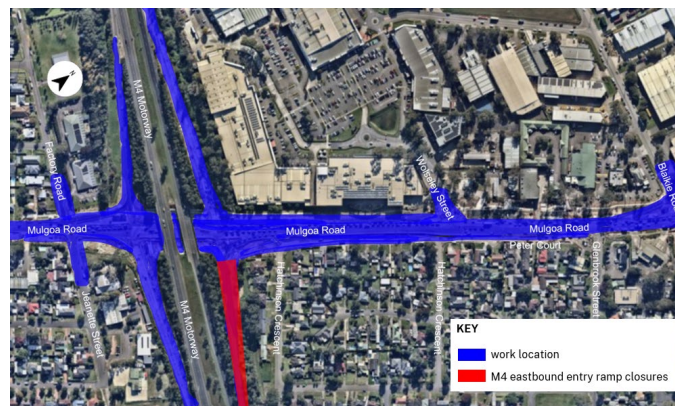
Night work along Mulgoa Road will include lane and road closures. Please observe speed limits, follow the directions of traffic controllers and signs, plan ahead and allow extra travel time.

## What will this mean for you?

While our work may be noisy at times, we will do everything we can to minimise the impact including turning off machinery when it's not in use. We aim to complete the noisier work before midnight however, some intermittent noise may occur after midnight.

You may hear sounds like squawking from reversing trucks or see flashing lights as we work to restore the site. These are essential to maintain safe work practices. Thank you for your patience during this important work.
