Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharug people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is continuing work on the Mulgoa Road upgrade between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road.

Night work is scheduled on 30 June, 1, 2, 3, 4, 7 and 8 July.

The eastbound and westbound exit ramps from the M4 to Mulgoa Road will be closed from 5am 7 July to 5am 9 July 2025.

We will be working on Mulgoa Road, at the corner of side streets and the M4 motorway ramps between **6pm and 7am**. The map on the next page shows the work locations.

In case of bad weather or operational issues, we will work on the night of **9 July 2025**.

What work are we doing?

- investigating, removing, building and maintaining road surfaces
- investigating and installing new utilities and drainage
- switching over to new utilities
- removing barriers
- restoring site when work is finished.

The stockpile site at 95 Blaikie Road will be used during this work.

Traffic changes day and night

Wolseley Street will be reduced to one lane in each direction from 5am Monday 30 June to 5am Saturday 5 July, and from 5am 7 July to 5am 9

July 2025. From **7pm to 5am** each night, Wolseley Street will be fully closed, except on Thursday, when the closure will begin at **10pm.** During the full closure, access will be available at Blaikie Road.

The eastbound and westbound exit ramps from the M4 to Mulgoa Road will be closed from **8pm to 5am on Monday 30 June and Wednesday 2 July**. Please detour via The Northern Road or Russell Street to access the M4 Motorway.

There will be a 48-hour closure of the eastbound and westbound exit ramps from the M4 to Mulgoa Road from **5am 7 July to 5am 9 July 2025.** Please detour via The Northern Road or Russell Street to access the M4 Motorway. During this time, the northbound slow lane on Mulgoa Road will be closed between Factory Road and Blaikie Road.

From 5am to 9am on Monday 30 June and Monday 7 July, the right turn entry from southbound Mulgoa Road and exit out of Wolseley Street will be closed. Please detour using the Glenmore Park roundabout and Pattys Place.

Night work along Mulgoa Road will include lane and road closures. Please observe speed limits, follow the directions of traffic controller and signs, plan ahead and allow extra travel time.

What will this mean for you? Access to Mulgoa Road from the M4 will be restricted and road users may face delays on Mulgoa Road and Wolseley Street.



While our work may be noisy at times, we will do everything we can to minimise the impact including turning off machinery when it's not in use. We aim to complete the noisier work before midnight however, some intermittent noise may occur after midnight.

You may hear sounds like squawking from reversing trucks or see flashing lights as we work to restore the site. These are essential to maintain safe work practices.
