Transport for NSW is continuing work on Mulgoa Road between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road.

What work are we doing?

We will be working on Mulgoa Road at the corner of side streets, and the M4 ramps. The map on the next page shows the work locations.

Work includes:

- investigating, removing, building and maintaining road surfaces
- investigating, installing and switching over to new utilities and drainage

- removing and installing barriers on the eastern side of Mulgoa Road
- restoring site when work is finished.

The stockpile site at 95 Blaikie Road will be used during this work

Night work is scheduled on Monday 15 September, Tuesday 16, Thursday 18, Monday 22 and Tuesday 23 September between 6pm and 7am.

In case of bad weather or operational issues, we will work on Wednesday 17, Friday 19 and Thursday 25 September 2025.

Traffic changes

The M4 eastbound entry ramp from Mulgoa Road to the M4



travelling towards the city will be closed on Monday 15, Tuesday 16, Monday 22 and Tuesday 23 September between 8pm and 5am. Please detour via The Northern Road or use the M4 westbound entry ramp to travel to Russell Street and access the ramp to the M4 travelling towards the city.

Blaikie Road (east) will be closed between **10pm and 5am** on the above nights.

Night work along Mulgoa Road will include lane and road closures. Please observe speed limits, follow the directions of traffic controllers and signs, plan ahead and allow extra travel time.


What will this mean for you?
