Transport for NSW is upgrading Mulgoa Road to improve traffic flow, safety and connectivity. This work is being delivered in two stages.

Stage 1: Jeanette Street to Blaikie Road

What work are we doing?

We've made significant progress on Stage 1, including utility relocations, drainage, reconstructing Wolseley Street intersection and Blaikie Road intersection and shifting traffic onto the newly built northbound lanes.

Work includes:

- finishing drainage and utility work
- building new road surfaces on the eastern side of Mulgoa Road
- installing medians along Mulgoa Road
- reconstructing intersections at Glenbrook Street and Jeanette Street
- installing noise wall piers and panels along Hatchinson Crescent, Huron Place and Peter Court.
- landscaping and installing street lighting

We will be using the stockpile site at 95 Blaikie Road as part of this work.

When and where we'll be working

Between Friday 1 August and Friday 19 December 2025, we will continue work on Mulgoa Road and surrounding streets between School House Road and Surveyors Creek. The map on the next page shows the work locations.

Our standard work hours are between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and between 8am and 1pm Saturdays. No work will take place on public holidays.

Due to high traffic volumes on Mulgoa Road, we will need to do some of this work at night to maintain access for businesses and residents and ensure the safety of workers and road users.

Unless otherwise notified, our night work hours are between 6pm and 7am. When we have to do night work, we will send you specific information before we start.

What equipment will we use?

You may notice the use of heavy machinery including:

- drills, jackhammers, excavators, vibratory rollers, and
- vacuum trucks, boring and saw-cutting equipment
- other trucks for transporting materials

Traffic changes

To enable work to progress in different areas and keep traffic moving, we'll need to keep making temporary traffic changes. We'll provide details of changes and exact dates closer to any work.

Traffic changes include:

- Glenbrook Street and Jeanette Street may have reduced access mostly during night work while we build the new road surface
- **Hatchinson Crescent** will be temporarily set-up as one-way traffic only at different times
- Peter Court will need to close at Glenbrook Street
- Ramps to and from the M4 will need to close at certain times.



Stage 2: Glenmore Parkway to Jeanette Street

What work are we doing?

We are currently finalising the project's detailed design, to prepare to start construction. As part of this design work, we will continue investigation work.

Work includes:

- surveying, ground and utility investigations
- installing temporary traffic controls, signs and site boundary flagging
- restoring work areas after we finish

We will also use the stockpile site at 95 Blaikie Road as part of this work.

When and where we'll be working

Between Friday 1 August and Friday 19 December 2025, we will continue to work on Mulgoa Road and surrounding streets between Gibbes Street, Glenmore Parkway and the M4 ramps. The map on the next page shows the work locations.

Our standard work hours are between **7am** and **6pm Monday to Friday** and between **8am** and **1pm Saturdays**. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays.

Due to high traffic volumes on Mulgoa Road, we will need to do some of this work at night to maintain access for businesses and residents and ensure the safety of workers and road users.

Unless otherwise notified, our night work hours are between **6pm and 7am.** We will not work more than two nights in a row and three nights in a week in the same location. We will notify nearby residents directly before we do any night work.

Traffic changes

There may be temporary traffic changes along Mulgoa Road during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe. Please keep to speed limits, follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs and allow extra travel time.

Managing our effects on the community


While our work on **Stages 1 and 2** may be noisy at times, we will do everything we can to minimise the impact including turning off machinery when it's not in use.

We aim to complete the noisier work before midnight; however, some intermittent noise may occur after midnight.

You may hear sounds like squawking from reversing trucks or see flashing lights as we work to restore the site. These are essential to maintain safe work practices.

Both Stage 1 and 2 project sites will close over the holiday period after 19 December 2025 and resume on Monday 5 January 2026. Thank you for your patience during this important work.
