Traffic switch on Mulgoa Road between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road from Monday 28 July

Mulgoa Road upgrade Stage 1
July 2025









Transport for NSW acknowledges the Darug people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is continuing work on the Mulgoa Road upgrade between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road.

From **Monday 28 July**, traffic will start moving onto the newly built road on the western side of Mulgoa Road to allow for ongoing work and upgrades on the eastern side. The traffic changes will be in place until the end of the project in 2026.

To prepare for the traffic switch, work will include removing safety barriers and installing barrier boards and bollards.

Once the traffic switch is completed:

- the M4 eastbound on ramp slip lane from southbound Mulgoa Road will be closed. Road users can instead access the ramp by turning left at the newly installed traffic lights.
- the new footpath on the western side between Factory Road and Blaikie Road will be open.
- two lanes will remain open in each direction along Mulgoa Road

When and where are we working?

The traffic switch will take place on Monday 28 July, Tuesday 29 July and Thursday 31 July from 6pm to 7am, weather permitting.

In case of bad weather or operational issues, we will work on **Monday 4 August**, **Tuesday 5 August and Thursday 7 August**.

We will be working on Mulgoa Road, at the corner of side streets and the M4 motorway ramps. The map on the next page shows the work locations.

Traffic changes

Temporary traffic changes will be in place during night work while we safely complete the switch in stages.

After the traffic switch is in place, road users are expected to experience minimal delays. However, we recommend allowing some extra travel time while road users adjust to the new traffic arrangements.

What will this mean for you?

While our work may be noisy at times, we will do everything we can to minimise the impact including turning off machinery when it's not in use.

We aim to complete the noisier work before midnight however, some intermittent noise may occur after midnight.



A traffic switch is a construction technique that involves moving traffic onto a new or different section of road. This allows us to keep road users moving while we safely build upgrades on other parts of the existing road.
