Transport for NSW is continuing work on Mulgoa Road between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road

What work are we doing?

We will be working on Mulgoa Road, at the corner of side streets, and the M4 ramps. The map on the next page shows the work locations.

Work includes:

- investigating, removing, building and maintaining road surfaces
- investigating, installing and switching over to newly installed utilities and drainage

- barrier removal and installing barriers on eastern side of Mulgoa Road
- · restoring site when work is finished.

The stockpile site at 95 Blaikie Road will be used during this work.

Night work is scheduled on Monday 21, Tuesday 22, Wednesday 23, Thursday 24, Friday 25, Monday 28, Tuesday 29 and Thursday 31 July between **6pm and 7am.**

In case of bad weather or operational issues, we'll work on Wednesday 30 July 2025.

Day and night traffic changes

Wolseley Street will be reduced to one lane in each direction from 5am Monday 21 July to 5am Saturday 26

July. Wolseley Street will be fully closed from 7pm to 5am each night, except on Thursday, when the closure will begin at 10pm. During the full closure, access will be available at Blaikie Road.

From **5am to 9am on Monday 21 July**, the right turn entry from southbound Mulgoa Road and exit out of Wolseley Street will be closed. Please detour using the Glenmore Park roundabout and Pattys Place.

The eastbound and westbound exit ramps from the M4 to Mulgoa Road will be closed from **7pm to 5am on Monday 28 July and Tuesday 29 July**. Please detour via The Northern Road or Russell Street to access the M4 Motorway.

Night work along Mulgoa Road may include lane and road closures. Please observe speed limits, follow the directions of traffic controller and signs, plan ahead and allow extra travel time.

What will this mean for you?

While our work may be noisy at times, we will do everything we can to minimise the impact including turning off machinery when it's not in use. We aim to complete the noisier work before midnight; however, some intermittent noise may occur after midnight.

You may hear sounds like squawking from reversing trucks or see flashing lights as we work to restore the site. These are essential to maintain safe work practices.

We appreciate your patience and understanding while we complete this important work.


