

# Investigation work in Richmond and North Richmond from 26 June 2025

## New Richmond Bridge Stage 2

June 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharug people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

The Australian and NSW governments have committed \$500 million for traffic improvements including a new bridge over the Hawkesbury River between Richmond and North Richmond. The Australian Government funding is provided under the Infrastructure Investment Program.

Transport for NSW needs to do further on site investigations as we continue planning for the New Richmond Bridge Stage 2 project.

### What work are we doing?

Our investigation work will involve digging and drilling holes to check ground conditions and utilities.

We will restore the areas when our investigations are finished. To complete this day and night investigation work, we will use:

- light vehicles
- a drilling rig
- vacuum truck
- survey equipment
- testing and scanning equipment
- lighting towers and
- small hand tools.

### When and where we'll be working

We will start work from **Thursday 26 June** and continue until **Friday 29 August**.

Work during the day will occur on **weekdays** between **7am** and **6pm** and **Saturdays** between **8am** and **1pm**.

We will need to do some of this work at night to minimise traffic disruptions and reduce safety risks to workers and road users.

Our night shift hours would be between **8pm** and **7am** from **Sunday** to **Thursday**.

### What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- workers and vehicles
- traffic controllers and signs
- lane closures and reduced speed limits
- noise from machinery and equipment.

The work may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including:

- completing noisier tasks earlier in the shift
- staging the work in different areas to minimise disruption in the same locations

### Managing our impacts

We will try to minimise disruption to traffic. However, there will be some temporary traffic changes at times to ensure the work areas are safe. Partial lane closures and a reduced speed limit may be in place.

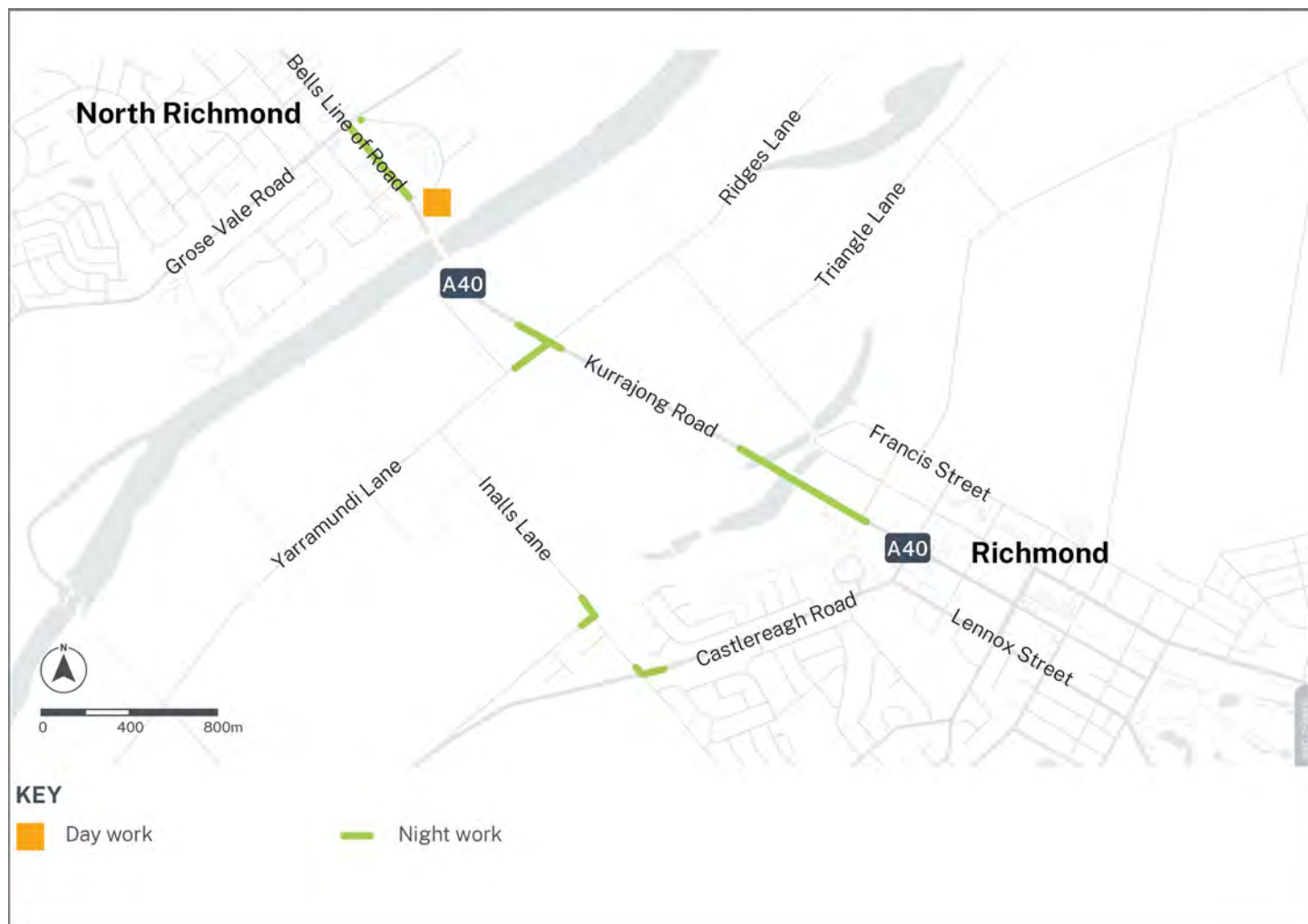
Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
