


# Rail Service Improvement Program

#### **Newtown to Redfern**

April 2025

The Rail Service Improvement
Program, formerly known as More
Trains, More Services, enables a safer,
more equitable, and integrated
transport network where people can
travel more safely, reliably, and
efficiently across NSW.

#### What work are we doing?

In April, we will be completing electrical infrastructure work inside the rail corridor at Newtown and Macdonaldtown.

This work will include:

- removal of redundant signal gantry and electrical infrastructure
- upgrading the existing rail infrastructure.

## When and where we'll be working

Work will be undertaken inside and adjacent to the rail corridor between Macdonaldtown Station and Station Street, Newtown.

We will be using our site compound on Railway Parade near Macdonaldtown Stabling Yard and will establish temporary laydown areas for plant and worker parking, as well as access at:

- the corner of Station and Wilford Streets,
- inside Newtown Station via Angel Street, and
- inside Macdonaldtown Stabling Yard via Burren Street.

Workers will use foot access to Newtown Station on Angel Street and to Macdonaldtown Station on Burren Street.

Standard construction hours on this project are between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm on Saturdays.

#### Out of hours work

Some work is required to take place outside of standard construction hours, between 6pm Thursday 3 April and 6am Tuesday 8 April 2025.

# Why we work outside of construction hours

We schedule work outside of standard construction hours to take place during Sydney Trains trackwork periods when no trains are running, minimising disruptions to commuter services and improving the safety of our construction team and customers.

# What will this mean for you?

Work will not be continuous, however, you may notice:

- · workers and construction vehicles
- increased noise from machinery and equipment, including mobile cranes, hand tools, and other plant.

### Managing our impacts

We understand construction activities may cause disruption to our closest neighbours, and every effort will be made to minimise impacts where possible.



## Easter and Anzac Day shutdown period

Work will not occur over the Easter and Anzac Day period in April.

We will be shutdown from;

- Friday 18 April returning to work on Tuesday 22 April
- Friday 25 April.

You may notice standard security checks in these work locations at this time.
