

Upcoming work on Bridge Road

Bridge Road Cycleway, Glebe

October 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gadigal, Wangal and Bidjigal people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is continuing work to deliver a range of improvements to Bridge Road, including an upgraded cycleway, two raised pedestrian crossings and a resurfaced road.

What work are we doing?

October marks an important milestone in the project. We'll finish trench restoration work and we'll begin resurfacing Bridge Road. We'll also start to build the new cycleway and access ramps between the cycleway and footpath. This work will deliver a smoother road and support safer journeys for people using the footpath and riding bikes.

Work includes:

- Trench restoration
- Resurfacing Bridge Road
- Installing the permanent cycleway
- Construction of new ramps to provide access between the cycleway and the footpath
- Temporary and permanent line marking.

Upcoming night work

From **Tuesday 30 September to Thursday 2 October**, we'll be working on Lyons Road (we've provided a separate update about this work). We'll continue working in the same area the following week, from **Tuesday 7 to Thursday 9 October**.

From **Tuesday 14 to Thursday 16 October**, we'll be working on Bridge Road from Jarocin Avenue to Glebe Point Road.

From **Tuesday 21 to Thursday 23 October**, we'll continue the trench restoration on Bridge Road from Brougham Lane to Darling Street.

We'll only work for up to three nights per week in one location to minimise impacts to the community.

Our working hours are from **8pm to 5am Sunday to Thursday**. Noisy and high impact work will be carried out before midnight when possible. Property access be maintained at all times.

Weekend work from 18 October

- From **Saturday 18 to Monday 20 October**, and **Saturday 25 to Monday 27 October**, we'll carry out road resurfacing and start concrete works for the cycleway separator on Bridge Road between **Lyons Road and Ross Street**.

Weekend working hours are from **8pm Saturday to 5am Monday**. Residents directly affected by weekend work will be notified in advance by door knocks and letterbox dropped community updates.

What will this mean for you?

Work will be noisy at times. We'll be using excavators, jack hammers, saw cutters and machines to remove the road surface, as well as compaction equipment and concrete agitators and tipper trucks.

You'll also notice:

- Temporary traffic changes, road closures and reduced speed limits
- Footpath closures



- Detours with traffic controllers on site to guide people using sections of the footpath and cycleway.

Please observe traffic change information and traffic control directions.

Managing our impacts

We understand that night work can cause disruption, particularly due to noise, light, and vibration from construction machinery. To help reduce these impacts, we're putting several noise mitigation measures in place, including:

- Turning off machinery when not in use
- Installing noise-reducing blankets and shade cloths around work areas

- Pointing lights away from residential buildings where possible
- Using quieter equipment
- Fitting machines with noise suppression mufflers to reduce engine noise.

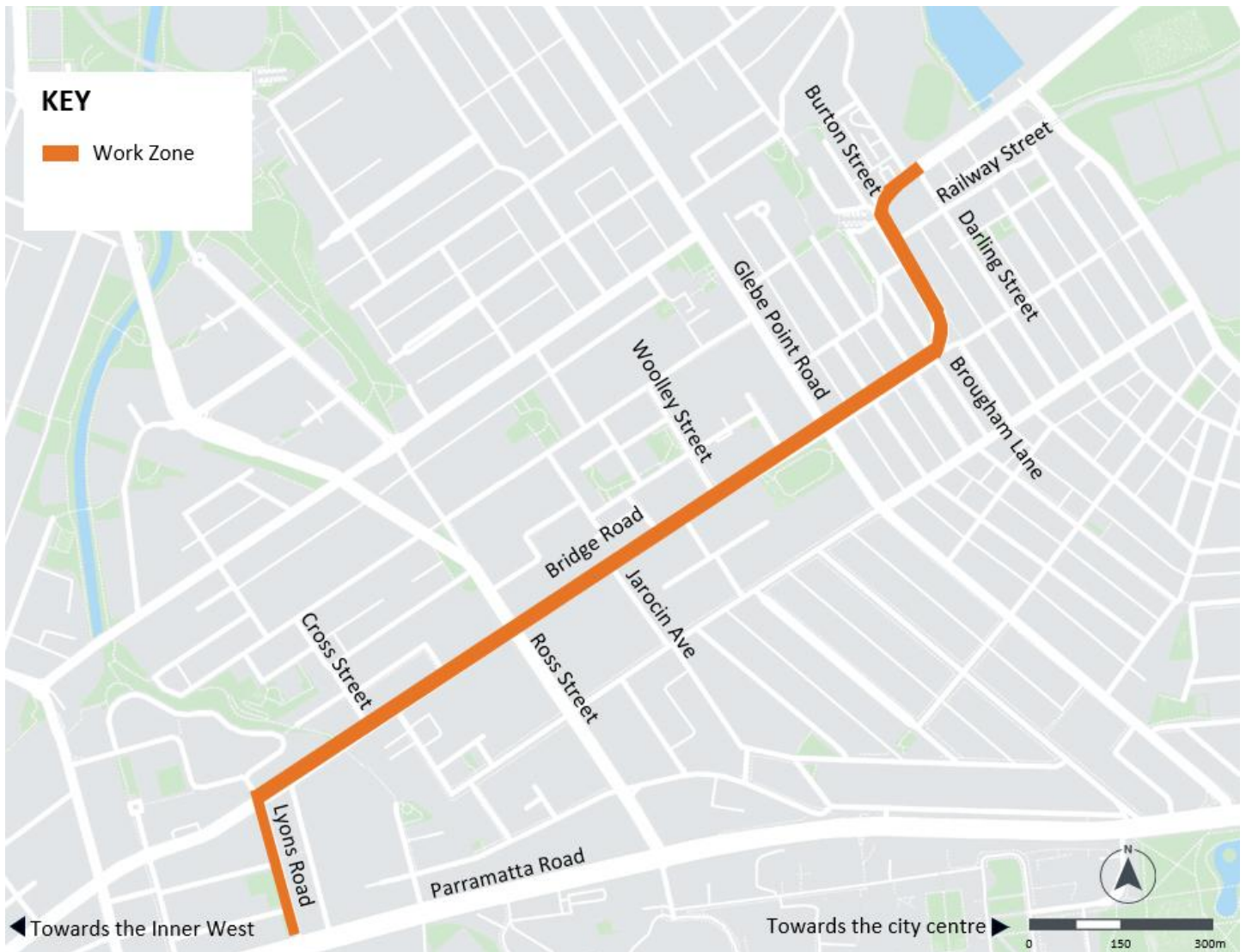
