# Safety improvements on Old South Head Road, Rose Bay

### **Road Safety Program**

October 2025









Transport for NSW acknowledges the Bidiagal, Birrabirragal and Gadigal people as the traditional custodians of the surrounding lands and waterways on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is improving safety on Old South Head Road, near Strickland Street and Hamilton Street, Rose Bay.

The Road Safety Program, which was launched in early 2024, aims to improve safety and reduce crashes on NSW roads. The Australian and NSW governments are investing \$518 million into road safety projects across NSW.

#### What work are we doing

From **Monday 3 November**, we'll be carrying out site investigation work at night, including:

- locating underground utilities
- geotechnical investigations
- topographical surveys

These site investigations will help us understand the feasibility of upgrading the pedestrian crossing on Old South Head Road near Strickland and Hamilton streets.

#### What changes are we investigating

This investigation work will inform planning to upgrade the existing zebra crossing with a raised 'wombat' crossing, to slow down vehicles and improve safety for people walking, riding and driving.

We are in the early design stages and aim to implement these changes in mid-2026.

#### When we'll be working

We will be working on Old South Head Road, Rose Bay, for up to **four-night shifts** between **Monday 3 November and Thursday 13 November 2025**, weather permitting.

Working hours are **8pm to 5am, Sunday to Thursday.** There will be no work on Friday nights, Saturdays, or public holidays.

#### What this means for you

There will be temporary traffic changes while we complete this work at night. This includes lane closures, and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h. Traffic control will be onsite to help road users and pedestrians.

Please keep to the speed limits and follow the direction of traffic control and signs.

Access to properties will be maintained.

We will liaise with nearby businesses and impacted properties on proposed changes.



#### Managing our impacts

Our work needs to be carried out at night to minimise disruption to traffic and reduce safety risks to our workers, pedestrians, and motorists.


It may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise our impacts by:

- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- completing noisier tasks, such as jackhammering, by midnight
- using quieter equipment where possible
- targeted lighting to minimise light spill.
