

# From Monday 21 July to Friday 31 August 2025

### What we are doing

To improve service reliability, Sydney trains will complete maintenance work on the existing retaining wall at Olympic Park along Brushbox Street and Sarah Durack Avenue from Monday 21 July to Friday 31 August.

Work activities include:

- Installation of soil anchors and injecting cement grout
- Construction of support beams at the pedestrian access level
- Installation of steel columns and angles to support the existing retaining wall.

We understand this work may have an impact on you and we appreciate your patience and understanding.

## How this affects you

### Pedestrian and bicycle ramp

- The pedestrian and bicycle ramp next to Brushbox Street will be temporarily closed during works.
- Detours will be in place for pedestrians and cyclists along Brushbox Street and Sarah Durack Avenue.
- The pedestrian underpass near Australia Avenue will remain open.
- The ramp on the south side of Sarah Durack Avenue will also remain open.

#### Noise

- These works may create additional noise Monday to Friday and potential weekends.
- Work will take place from 7am to 5pm Monday 21 July to Friday 31 August.
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to daytime travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment.


### Traffic and parking

- Heavy vehicles will use local streets to access worksites. Parking will be limited near access gates.
- We will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, however please be aware that onstreet parking may be limited near worksites.
- Traffic controllers will be on duty to assist motorists and pedestrians throughout the duration of the works.
