## UPDATED DATES: London Road and Link Road open to traffic from Monday 21 July

# Parkes Bypass Newell Highway upgrade











Transport for NSW acknowledges the Wiradjuri People as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

The Australian and NSW Governments are investing in the Parkes Bypass to improve connectivity, road transport efficiency and safety for all motorists. Construction of the bypass is nearing completion, and some key activities are taking place.

What work are we doing?

From Monday 21 July, Link Road will reopen to traffic, weather permitting, connecting Brolgan Road with Hartigan Avenue.

London Road between the bypass and Saleyards Road will reopen to two-lane traffic with the temporary traffic signals to be removed later in the week, weather permitting.

Line marking on the northern connection will take place on **Sunday 20 July**, and works on the Parkes Golf Club driveway will be completed in the coming weeks.

Traffic changes that remain in place

While remaining construction activities for the Parkes Bypass project are completed, the following traffic changes remain in place:

- the main access to the Bypass from within Parkes remains the Condobolin Road roundabout until remaining work is completed
- the northern connection is now open to traffic and provides a convenient option to enter and exit the bypass north of Parkes.

What other work is to be completed?

While many of the elements of the bypass are now complete there are still some finishing works remaining, including completing construction of the southern connection road, line marking, landscaping, wayfinding and signage.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- changed traffic conditions including road and lane closures, reduced speed limits
- traffic controllers and signage in place
- noise from machinery and equipment.

All road users are encouraged to plan ahead and allow extra time for all journeys.




## Managing our impacts
