



# Night work in Pitt Town from Monday 30 June 2025

## Community Notification

June 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Darug and Gundungarra peoples as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is building the Pitt Town Bypass to take traffic, including heavy vehicles out of the town centre. This will make travel quicker and safer for all road users.

### What work are we doing?

During the project we will need to work at night to reduce traffic disruption and increase safety for road users and our workers.

As part of our early work preparing for major construction to start, we need to schedule a small amount of upcoming night work. This night work will be to:

- install temporary traffic barriers and road signs and markers
- remove existing and install new temporary linemarking

### When and where we'll be working

We will need to work **one night shift**, either on **Monday 30 June** or **Tuesday 1 July 2025**, weather permitting. Our working hours will be between **7pm and 5am**.

We will be working on sections of Cattai Road, Eldon Street, Old Pitt Town Road, Glebe Road and Pitt Town Road. Please see map on the next page showing these locations.

### Traffic impacts

There will be temporary traffic impacts while we complete this work. This includes lane closures and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h. We will also use traffic control to help road users through the work area. Please keep to the speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

### What will this mean for you?

While we work, you will notice:

- workers and vehicles
- traffic controllers and signage
- temporary lane closures and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h
- noise from machinery and equipment.

The work will improve safety for motorists driving near the work areas as we prepare to start construction on the project.

### Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment by:

- completing noisy work activities by midnight where possible
- turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use
- using noise blankets to reduce noise where space allows
