



Riverwood Station Lift 1 Upgrade

From Monday 13 October to Monday 15 December 2025

What we are doing

To improve service reliability, Sydney Trains is undertaking major lift replacement work at Riverwood Station from Monday 13 October to Monday 15 December.

Work activities include the upgrading of Lift 1. This lift provides access from street level to Platform 1 and 2.

We understand this work may have an impact on you and we appreciate your patience and understanding.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise at night and over the weekend.
- Work will take place from:
 - 8am to 5pm Sunday 12 October
 - 7am to 5pm Monday to Saturday from Monday 13 October to Saturday 13 December
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to daytime travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Finishing works including the removal of equipment may take place beyond the dates stated above.

Access to Platform 1 and 2

- Lift 1 will be unavailable from Monday 13 October to Monday 15 December.
- During the work, passengers requiring lift access will be required to take Bus 940 at Thurlow Street to Narwee Station to continue their journey.

Traffic and parking

- Heavy vehicles will use local streets to access the rail corridor. Parking will be limited near access gates.
- We will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, however please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksites.
