

Sheahan Bridge site visits and investigations at Gundagai

Transport for NSW is carrying out field investigations along Sheahan Bridge at Gundagai to help early planning for the bridge upgrade project.

What work are we doing?

We are working with a contractor, WSP Australia Pty Ltd and their sub-contractors, to develop concept designs and assess environmental impacts for a potential upgrade or replacement of the Hume Highway northbound bridge over the Murrumbidgee River and floodplain.

As part of the project's planning and investigations, we need to carry out site visits to help inform potential future improvements or upgrades at this location.

Work at the site will include:

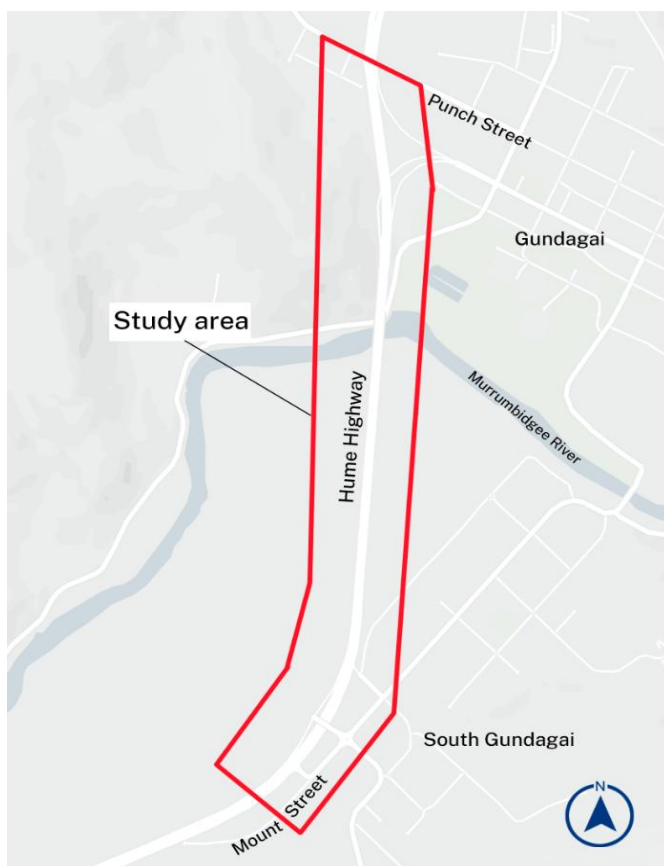
- bridge structure inspections
- mapping vegetation in the area
- ecological studies (night and day)
- cultural heritage studies
- surveying and geotechnical testing.

When we'll be working

We'll be working at the Sheahan Bridge study area at various times between **August and December 2025**.

Work hours are Monday to Friday between 7am and 6pm, with the exception of some environmental studies which may need to be carried out outside of these hours.

You may notice workers and vehicles in the bridge area. Work is being planned between August and December and may require access to private properties.

Property owners will be contacted directly before this work is carried out to discuss any access requirements to the property.
