From **Monday 25 August 2025**, we'll start work to demolish the former Central Squeeze building in the northern corner of Eddy Avenue Plaza. This work will make room for the hydrant boosters to be relocated from the main plaza.

What work are we doing?

Switching off water and power supply to the building

- Removing interior lining, fittings and shop frontage
- Installing timber boxing around the stone column to protect it during construction
- Installing new fencing.

Out of hours work

This work will be completed at night to help minimise any impacts on pedestrian access.

Work will take about **three nights** to complete between **9.30pm and 5.30am** from **Monday 25 August** to **Thursday 4 September 2025.** We do not work Friday evenings, Saturdays or public holidays.
