



Night work on Swansea Bridge, Swansea, from Monday 15 September

The NSW Government is investing in essential maintenance work to ensure the safe and reliable operation of the bridge.

What work are we doing?

Transport for NSW (Transport) will carry out work to the southbound opening span deck and essential biannual service work, which includes inspecting and testing the electrical, mechanical and hydraulic components and the emergency systems of the bridge.

When and where we'll be working

We'll be carrying out night work in two stages. The first stage will start from **Monday 15 September** and is expected to be completed in **two weeks**, weather permitting.

The second stage of night work will start from **Monday 20 October** and is expected to be completed in **two weeks**, weather permitting.

Our work hours are **7pm to 5am** from **Monday to Thursday**.

We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside of these times.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- workers and vehicles
- traffic controllers and signage
- one bridge will remain open at all times, operating with one lane in each direction
- a reduced speed limit of 40km/h.

Swansea Bridge will not open to marine traffic during the night shifts.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

We will minimise impact by:

- reducing our noise as much as possible
- turning off machinery when not in use.
