



Night work on Swansea Bridge, Swansea on Monday 28 April

The NSW Government is investing in essential maintenance work to ensure the safe and reliable operation of the bridge.

What work are we doing?

Transport for NSW will carry out the work, which includes material delivery to the plant room and inspections and testing the emergency systems on the southbound bridge. Bridge lifts will be required during this work.

When and where we'll be working

We'll be working on **Monday 28 April** and expect to complete the work in **one shift**, weather permitting.

Working hours are **7pm to 5am**, weather permitting.

We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside of these times.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- Workers and vehicles
- Traffic controllers and signage
- The northbound bridge will remain open at all times, operating with one lane in each direction
- A reduced speed limit of 40km/h.

The bridge will not be open to marine traffic while the work is carried out.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

We will minimise impact by:

- Reducing our noise as much as possible
- Turning off machinery when not in use.
