Tallawong to Sydenham station maintenance works

Saturday 6 to Sunday 7 September 2025

What we are doing

There will be planned trackwork at M1 North West & Bankstown Line stations and facilities from 2.30am Saturday 6 September to 2.00am Monday 8 September.

Metro Trains Sydney (MTS) will carry out the following activities across all metro stations, from

Tallawong to Sydenham:

- Workers on foot completing track inspections and preventative maintenance using handheld tools
- Signalling works
- Tunnel leak rectification
- Track welding, tamping and grinding
- Overhead wire replacement and inspection
- Tunnel jet fan maintenance and replacement
- General preventative and corrective maintenance
- Hi-rail vehicles entering at Bella Vista, Epping, Chatswood and Sydenham to complete overhead wiring cable works
- At Sydenham, tile removal works on the platform using hand tools, a hammer drill and a tile grinder, and removing and reinstalling platform screen doors, panels and posts

How this may affect you

Public transport changes:

Metro services will not run between Tallawong and Sydenham. Buses replace metro services between Tallawong and Chatswood. Use trains between Chatswood, the City and Sydenham.

Noise:

- This work may create some noise during the day and at night.
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the specified hours. Some deliveries may occur at night due to travel restrictions for large vehicles.
- Hi-rail vehicles and track machines may traverse the alignment and engines may be idling for extended periods.

Traffic and parking

While vehicles will be parked inside the rail corridor where possible, please be aware that on-street parking may be affected near worksites.
