

Terralong Street Kiama underbridge work From Monday 13 October to Friday 31 October 2025

What we are doing

Sydney Trains is replacing the Collision Protection Beams on Terralong Street at Kiama. The work will be completed in stages during scheduled weeknight and weekend rail closedowns. The next stage of work will take place from Monday 13 October to Friday 31 October.

Work will include placement of concrete kerbs, pavement works, removal of protection beams, and painting works along Terralong Street, Kiama.

We understand this work may have an impact on you and we appreciate your patience and understanding.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works will create additional noise on some nights and impact packing in the area.
- Work will take place from 7am to 5pm Monday to Friday, between Monday 13 October and Friday 31 October.
- Controls will be in place to minimise the noise impact, and we will try our best to accelerate the program.
- Machinery will be used throughout works and we will select low-noise equipment when available.
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to daytime travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Finishing works including the removal of equipment may take place beyond the dates stated above.

Traffic and parking

- There will be a temporary road closure in place along Terralong Street between Railway Parade and Manning Street from 7am to 5pm Monday to Friday, between Monday 13 October and Friday 31 October.
- There will be a detour in place for vehicles during this time. Please see map on following pages for details.
- Up to 10 parking spaces along Terralong Street will be temporarily unavailable from Monday 13 October to Friday 31 October to accommodate site sheds, amenities and material laydown.
- We will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, however please be aware that onstreet parking may be limited near worksite.
- Traffic controllers will be on duty to assist motorists and pedestrians throughout the duration of the works. Pedestrian access will be maintained.
- Work vehicles will use local streets to access the worksite.
