# WAT Operational Support Grant Program - Round 1 (2025)

# Who can apply?

You must be the registered owner of a Wheelchair Accessible Taxis (WATs) in NSW.

To be eligible, you must:

- Meet all criteria in the Grant Program Guidelines, and
- Be actively operating the vehicle at the time of application and payment

## How much funding is available in Round 1?

You can receive a one-off payment of \$2,500 per eligible WAT vehicle This payment is made directly to the vehicle owner.

### **What is the Metropolitan Transport District**

The Metropolitan Transport District is often referred to as the Sydney Region, and includes the areas as listed in the Program Guidelines Appendix A, shown below:

#### Can I apply if I operate outside the Metropolitan Transport District?

Yes. The grant is open to regional WAT vehicle owners, this includes areas such as Wollongong, Central Coast and Newcastle.

A regional WAT vehicle owner must meet the following criteria:

- complete at least one M50 job, or
- provide a confirmation email from your authorised Taxi Service Provider (TSP) showing recent WAT activity.

# What if I have more than one eligible vehicle?

You can use the same application for multiple vehicles. A WAT vehicle owner may receive \$2,500 for each vehicle, as long they meet the eligibility criteria. You will just need to enter each of the registration numbers in the registration field, separated by a comma as shown below:



You will also need to ensure the total grant value requested totals \$2,500 per vehicle in the budget section of the application form i.e. for 3 WAT vehicles the value would be changed to \$7,500.



#### When will Round 2 open?

Round 2 is expected to open early 2026. Eligibility and application details will be shared closer to the launch.

# Do I need to sign a funding agreement?

Yes. You must sign and submit the Funding Deed as part of your SmartyGrants application.

Should you have more than one vehicle you may use the same agreement for each vehicle application. Just make sure to upload it with each application separately.

#### Are grants taxable?

Yes. Most grants and payments are considered assessable income and must be included in the tax return. You are responsible for seeking your own independent financial, legal or tax advice.

#### When will I receive my grant?

If your application is complete and meets all eligibility requirements, payment will usually be made within 14 business days. Please note, payment timeframes may be extended due to high application volumes and the implementation of a new system.
