

Essential safety maintenance and repair work continues on Scabbing Flat Bridge

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Wiradjuri people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Essential safety maintenance and repair work continues on Scabbing Flat Bridge. In addition to existing load limits remaining in place, intermittent closures are planned in March and April to enable works to take place.

What work are we doing?

We will be replacing truss timbers, cross girders and installing a temporary propping structure on the bridge, which requires temporary closures to all traffic.

Work will take place **Monday to Friday** between **7am and 5pm.**

When will the bridge be closed?

The bridge will be **closed** between **9am and 3pm** every **Tuesday**, **Wednesday and Thursday** from **Tuesday 11 March** until **Thursday 24 April 2025**.

Please note that additional closures may be required for ongoing repairs, and we will notify you in advance.

What will this mean for you?

Bridge works will be conducted with traffic controllers present during working hours.

During the closure times, all vehicles can follow the detour routes listed.

Detour routes

Detour via Wellington:

- Allow up to 25 minutes of extra travel time
- Detour via Renshaw McGirr Way/Suntop Road/Arthurville Road.

Detour via Dubbo:

- Allow up to 45 minutes of extra travel time
- Detour via Obley Road/Benolong Road/Terrabella Road/Arthurville Road.

Please note there is a 16-tonne load limit on the bridge and heavy vehicles will need to use the detour routes at all times. We are working with the community to increase the load limit to 18-tonnes and will advise the community when we are able to confirm this.

We encourage all motorists to allow for additional travel time depending on your destination. A detailed map of the detour routes is included over the page for your reference.


