Survey Work on Newell Highway between Gurley and Moree, from Monday 23 May

The NSW and Australian Governments are jointly funding the \$261.17 million heavy duty pavement upgrade of the Newell Highway between Narrabri and Moree as part of the Newell Highway Upgrade program.

Initial survey work is being carried out to plan for the delivery of the first stage of the project which includes upgrading four priority sections along the Newell Highway with 27.3 kilometres of new road pavement, intersection improvements, widening of road shoulders and the provision of five additional overtaking lanes.

Lead Contractor Fulton Hogan will be carrying out the work on behalf of Transport for NSW which includes survey work along the Newell Highway between Gurley and Moree starting Monday 23 May. We have included a map to show the location of the work.

We will be working between **7.00am** and **6.00pm** from **Monday to Friday and 8:00am and 1:00pm Saturdays** and expect to complete the work in **4 weeks**, weather permitting. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve surveyors accessing various locations along the work area within the road corridor.

Access to your property will be maintained at all times during work hours. Please exercise caution as you enter and exit your property and be aware of workers on the roadside.

Traffic changes

There may be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs. For the latest traffic updates, you can call 132 701, visit livetraffic.com or download the Live Traffic NSW App.
