Banksia Station Upgrade

Project Update

November 2020

Transport for NSW is upgrading Banksia Station to make it easier for everyone to access, including people with a disability or limited mobility, parents/carers with prams, and customers with luggage.

Upcoming work

Site set up started in October and work will continue in November.

Activities will include:

- installing temporary fencing and hoarding in the station underpass and on station platforms
- demolition work in the station underpass, subject to approval
- excavating and trenching on Hattersley Street for new stormwater drainage
- excavating and constructing new kerb and stormwater drainage on Railway Street
- piling work on Railway Street and Hattersley Street for new lift pits
- early building work to the station building on Platform 2 and 3, subject to approval
- the removal of one tree on Hattersley Street
- installing a new electrical transformer within the grassy area on Taylor Avenue.

Equipment to be used includes jackhammers, demolition saw, piling rig, tipper trucks, plant station excavator, tipper trucks, flatbed truck for deliveries and hand tools.

Traffic control will be in place intermittently to ensure safe pedestrian and vehicle movements around the worksite. Some on street parking in surrounding streets may be temporarily used by trucks for deliveries.

Wherever possible, measures to reduce noise will be used including turning equipment off when not in use, positioning equipment as far away from residents and businesses as possible, using non-tonal reversing beepers and stopping work for respite periods.

Temporary parking impacts and construction laydown areas

From **Monday 16 November to mid-2021**, **15 on street parking spaces** will be temporarily impacted to allow for construction vehicles to move safely around the site and for deliveries. The temporary loss of parking includes:

- three parking spaces on Taylor Avenue
- 12 parking spaces on Hattersley Street.

A temporary laydown area will also be put in place on the grass area near the station between Taylor Avenue and Subway Road to store equipment and construction materials. This area will also be used as a work zone to install footings for an electrical transformer.
