Banksia Station Upgrade

Project Update

April 2021

Transport for NSW is improving accessibility at Banksia Station. The upgrade will provide a station precinct that is accessible to people with a disability or limited mobility, parents/carers with prams, and customers with luggage.

Night work – Monday 12 April to Thursday 15 April

For the safety of workers and the community, work will take place over three nights from **Monday 12 April to Thursday 15 April** between **6pm** and **7am**.

Steel reinforcements and formwork will occur at the lift shafts on Railway Parade and Hattersley Street. The work is not expected to be noisy.

Equipment to be used for the work includes lighting towers and powered hand tools.

Weekend work - Saturday 17 April and Sunday 18 April

For the safety of workers and community, from **1pm Saturday 17 April** to **5am Sunday 18 April** work will take place to install lift structural steel on Railway Street and Hattersley Street.

Equipment to be used includes lighting towers, elevated work platforms, crane, trucks and hand tools. There may be some noise associated with this work. Wherever possible, measures to reduce noise will be implemented including scheduling noisy work during daytime hours, turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use, monitoring noise, using non-tonal beepers and acoustic barriers.

Between 8pm Saturday 17 April to 5am Sunday 18 April, Railway Street will be closed to traffic between Godfrey Street and Bowmer Street. Access for buses and residential vehicles will be maintained.

The pedestrian underpass between Railway Street and Hattersley Street will be closed **between the last train** (expected around 2am) and **the first train** (expected around 5am) **on Sunday morning**. Pedestrians will need to detour via Subway Road during this time.

Other upcoming work

Other work activities continuing in April include:

- ongoing demolition work in the station underpass and station structure
- installing glazing and louvres to new lift shafts
- excavating and concrete pouring for new lift shafts

- continued lift steel work on Hattersley Street and Railway Street
- upgrades to the station toilets
- constructing new retaining walls
- adjusting temporary stairs and access to platforms and underpass
- constructing new stairs on platforms 1 and 4
- continued electrical work on Hattersley Street including installing a new electrical transformer
- continued storm water drainage work on Hattersley Street, Railway Street and in the underpass.

Equipment to be used includes cranes, tipper trucks, delivery trucks, excavators, vacuum truck, powered hand tools, ground compaction equipment and concrete trucks.

Ongoing pedestrian access and parking changes in April

Temporary stairs remain in place to provide access to both platforms 1 and 4. Three parking spaces on Taylor Avenue and up to 12 parking spaces on Hattersley Street are temporarily unavailable as they are being used for construction vehicles and deliveries. The taxi zone on Railway Street will be unavailable at times during work near the station entrance. These changes will be in place until mid-2021. We apologise for the inconvenience and thank you for your patience.

Construction hours

Standard construction hours are 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.
