- ✓ improved amenities including a new family accessible toilet and a new male and female ambulant toilet.
- ✓ upgrades to CCTV, lighting and wayfinding signage

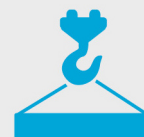

The removal of the site office, storage and laydown area is being undertaken during July, along with installation of new seats, water fountain and revegetation in and around the station. The new tactile ground surface indicators were installed during June and the lift is now operational and open to the public.
