#### COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

Transport for NSW is rolling out new technology to upgrade Sydney's rail network and introducing modern signalling as part of the Digital Systems Program.

Part of 'More Trains, More Services', the Digital Systems Program will replace current signalling and train control technology with modern, internationally proven, intelligent systems. It will help improve reliability and increase capacity on Sydney's railways once implemented widely across the network.

#### Work activity

Ongoing project work involves installing new track infrastructure inside the rail corridor along the Eastern Suburbs Line from Erskineville to Bondi Junction.

In coming weeks, you may notice the following activities:

- Installation and extension of existing power cable trays
- Site survey and investigation works.

Some additional cable tray installation work will be carried out at night.

These works are in line with current Public Health Orders and a COVID-19 Safe Plan is in place for all activity in the work area, including masks and QR codes.

## Upcoming work in your area

Between 9pm on Thursday 4 November and 5am on Friday 5 November we will be working inside the rail corridor near the rail tunnel entrance at McElhone Street, Woolloomooloo. Activity will involve installation of cable trays along the rail corridor.

The work in your area will not be continuous. Every effort will be made to keep noisy works to a minimum and reduce impacts to the community whenever possible.

## What you may notice

Equipment used during the work activity will include elevated work platforms, a crane truck, lighting towers, power tools such as drills and hand tools such as a small vacuum.

Transport for NSW is committed to minimising noise impacts on the community. We switch off equipment when it is not being used, place equipment as far away from properties as possible and monitor our work activities to make sure noise levels are being managed effectively.
