COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

Transport for NSW (TfNSW) is rolling out new technology to upgrade Sydney's rail network and introducing modern signalling as part of the Digital Systems Program.

Part of 'More Trains, More Services', the Digital Systems Program will replace current signalling and train control technology with modern, internationally proven, intelligent systems. It will help improve reliability and increase capacity on Sydney's railways once implemented widely across the network.

Project overview

Initial work will involve installing new track infrastructure along the Cronulla branch of the Illawarra line from Sutherland to Cronulla.

Upcoming works

Over the coming months, you may notice the following activities:

- Cable installation in conduits
- Excavation of trenches
- Stockpiling works in various locations along the rail corridor
- Site survey and investigation works
- Night activities (mostly survey works and cable installation only).

Weekend work - Saturday 26 June to Monday 28 June 2021

From 6am Saturday 26 June to 6am Monday 28 June, works are planned during a Sydney Trains scheduled trackwork weekend. Work activities will include cable installation in conduits to upgrade the current signalling system and stockpiling works in preparation for the cable installation. The work in your area will not be continuous. Every effort will be made to keep noisy works to a minimum and to reduce impacts to the community whenever possible.

What equipment will be used?

Equipment will include excavators, vacuum trucks, powered hand tools, lighting towers, construction vehicles and traffic control vehicles.

Traffic control and signage will be in place for the safety of workers and the community.

Construction hours

All other work will be carried out during standard construction hours, Monday to Friday between 7am and 6pm and Saturdays 8am to 1pm. The community will be notified of any works outside these hours prior to the works commencing. We apologise for any inconvenience caused and thank you for your cooperation during these important works.

What you may notice

Equipment and machinery used during standard construction hours will include various hand tools, construction trucks, excavators and work vehicles.

Transport for NSW is committed to minimising noise impacts on the community. We switch off equipment when it is not being used, place equipment as far away from properties as possible and monitor our work activities to make sure noise levels are being managed effectively.

To ensure the safety of our customers and staff, this work will be completed during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork weekend. Train services will be affected during weekend work.
