



ORDER SETTING MANDATORY STANDARDS AND GIVING DIRECTIONS

under the

PORTS AND MARITIME ADMINISTRATION REGULATION 2021

I, Rob Sharp, Secretary of the Department of Transport, on behalf of Transport for NSW, being a delegate of the Minister, under the specified provision of the Ports and Maritime Administration Regulation 2021, do as follows:

- (1) Set, under section 44, the mandatory standards in connection with the provision of truck servicing by stevedores at Port Botany in the attached document entitled “Port Botany Landside Operations Mandatory Standards under Part 6 of the Ports and Maritime Administration Regulation 2021”; and
- (2) Give, under section 46, the directions contained in the attached document entitled “Port Botany Landside Operations Mandatory Standards under Part 6 of the Ports and Maritime Administration Regulation 2021”.

Revocation of previous Order

The Order setting mandatory standards and giving directions included in the mandatory standards as published in the NSW Government Gazette No 115 of 18 December 2015 is revoked.

Date of Effect and Termination

This Order takes effect on 1 September 2021 and will continue in force until revoked.

This Order may be revoked at any time by the Minister.
