

Power Supply Upgrade

AC Feeder Upgrade Project – out of hours work

In our recent community notification about the AC Feeder power supply upgrade work at Revesby and Bankstown we informed you of works taking place in August 2022.

As part of these works, we will be carrying out work at night on **Mons Street, Milperra Road and Albert Street** to install new power poles and string conductors.

Out of hours night work on Wednesday 17 and Thursday 18 August 2022

To minimise impact to the community and to enable the construction team to safely carry out these essential activities, this work will occur:

- between **6pm on Wednesday 17 August 2022** and **7am on Thursday 18 August 2022**
- between **6pm on Thursday 18 August 2022** and **7am on Friday 19 August 2022**.

Prior to starting this work, delivery of plant and materials and setting up of safety barriers and traffic control will be carried out. This work will involve:

- the temporary removal of kerbside parking near the work area
- temporary pedestrian diversions
- mobilising plant and materials including placement of mobile cranes and elevated work platforms (EWPs)
- drilling holes and installing new power poles and stringing conductors
