


Blackheath Station Upgrade

Transport Access Program | Community Update

May to June 2023





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharug and Gundungurra peoples as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is upgrading Blackheath Station, with the work expected to be completed in late 2023.

The project is being delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, which aims to provide station precincts that are accessible to people with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

What work are we doing?

Construction on the Blackheath Station Upgrade is progressing well. Activities will continue through May to June 2023 and include:

- Service installation works to new lift shafts
- Roofing, cladding and glazing works to new lift shafts
- Installation of tactiles on the station platform
- Civil works at station entrances and commuter car park
- Finishing works
- Power supply upgrade works along the Great Western Highway

Equipment to be used includes surveying equipment, mobile crane, small drilling rig, excavators, trucks, concrete pumps, power and hand tools.

Weekend work - 26 to 29 May 2023

Work will be carried out from 10pm on Friday 26 May and 7am on Monday 29 May 2023 during a scheduled Sydney Trains track work period, when the station is closed and no trains are running.

Work will include:

- Resurfacing of the platform (subject to weather conditions)
- Installation of new signal equipment on the track
- Finishing and cladding works to new lift shafts
- Installation of new services within the station precinct

Equipment to be used includes excavators, concrete trucks, concrete pumps, dumpers, elevated work platforms, surveying equipment, construction trucks, power, and hand tools.

Parking and access changes

To enable planned weekend works:

- The station's kiss and ride zone will be relocated to the front of Blackheath Station on the Great Western Highway from 10pm on Friday 26 May and 7am on Monday 29 May
- The station's existing footbridge will be closed from 12am on Saturday 27 May to 5am on Monday 29 May. Alternative access across the rail corridor will be available at the Bundarra Street level crossing during this time.
- The car park on Station Street will be closed from Monday 22 May to Monday 29 May to allow deliveries, set up of equipment and preliminary works.



Construction hours

Standard construction hours are **7am** to **6pm Monday** to **Friday** and **8am** to **1pm** on **Saturdays**.

For the safety of staff, customers and the community, some work will be completed outside standard construction hours.

We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance if additional night or weekend work is required.
