



DC Feeder Upgrade Project – Gordon

Power Supply Upgrade

August and September 2023



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Darramuragal people of the Ku-ring-gai country as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is making improvements to electrical infrastructure to meet expected power requirements for Sydney's future rail network and new fleet of air-conditioned trains. As part of this, Transport for NSW is carrying out power supply upgrade work through our DC Feeder Upgrade Project.

What work are we doing?

The DC Feeder Upgrade Project will improve power delivery to the railway across a number of sites on the rail network, including Gordon.

In August and September 2023 we will:

- remove redundant cables and install new cables
- work on electrical infrastructure such as overhead wiring and metal fixings.

Where we'll be working

Work will take place inside the rail corridor and inside the substation located on Werona Avenue as shown on the map overleaf.

When we'll be working

Standard construction hours are between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm on Saturdays.**

Some deliveries will take place out-of-hours due to their oversized nature. You may notice deliveries between:

- **6pm Wednesday 23 August and 7am Thursday 24 August**
- **6pm Thursday 24 August and 7am Friday 25 August**
- **6pm Friday 25 August and 8am Saturday 26 August.**

Some work will also take place out-of-hours from **6am Saturday 26 August to 6am Monday 28 August.**

This work will take place during scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork periods when no trains will be running. Scheduling work outside of standard construction hours enables us to complete essential work safely.

Temporary parking changes

From **7pm Wednesday 23 August to 10pm Monday 28 August** up to **seven parking spaces** will be unavailable in the commuter carpark on Werona Avenue, near the intersection with Khartoum Avenue, to facilitate construction activities.

Please note that Sydney Trains will also be working in Gordon during this time and will temporarily close the commuter carpark on Werona Avenue near the intersection with McIntosh Street.

In addition to the temporary parking changes on Werona Avenue, you may notice:

- workers and vehicles
- noise from machinery and equipment
- lighting towers
- traffic controllers in the area.
