

Mariyung Fleet Maintenance Facility - Traction Substation

Traction substation work

The Mariyung Fleet Maintenance Facility at Kangy Angy is purpose built to service and maintain the Mariyung fleet of intercity trains, which will progressively replace the aging V set trains across the intercity network.

UGL Limited operate and maintain the facility on behalf of Transport for NSW and NSW TrainLink.

Upcoming work – Friday 17 to Sunday 19 March 2023

We will be working from 5pm Friday 17 March to 10pm Sunday 19 March within the traction substation, located on Enterprise Drive.

Work activities will include:

- Temporary removal of the traction substation roof
- Installation of electrical equipment into the substation
- Reinstatement of traction substation roof
- Minor work within the traction substation building.

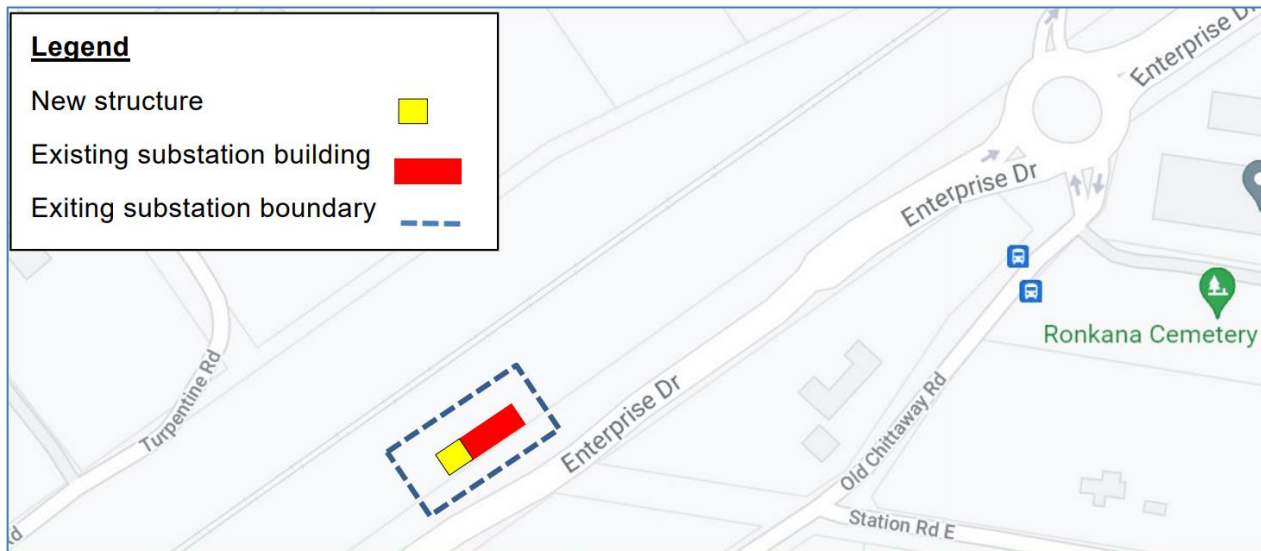
All work will be completed within the existing substation facility site.

What you may notice

As the work is being conducted within the site, impacts to the community are expected to be minimal, however the following will be managed by the onsite team and any impacts minimised as much as possible.

- Noise:** Construction noise is expected to be minimal, mainly from mobile crane movements and an elevated work platform.
- Traffic:** Construction vehicles will access the site via Enterprise Drive. No traffic control measures will be required as the vehicles will be moving into the substation premises. Local traffic will be given priority at all times.

A range of equipment will be used to complete the work, including:

- Mobile crane
- Hand and power tools
- Elevated work platform
- Generator

Update on internal site work

In December 2022, UGL commenced mobilisation works within the facility site to enhance the efficiency and capacity of their operations. All work will be completed within the existing facility site – there is no change to the site size or what ongoing train maintenance activities are completed.

Throughout January and February 2023, work activities have included site establishment and early works for construction of a storage building for materials and a 5th rail track into the main building.
