

AC Feeder Upgrade Project – Bankstown, Revesby

Power Supply Upgrade

September 2023



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Darug and Eora Nations as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

The AC Feeder Upgrade Project is part of the Power Supply Upgrade which is designed to meet expected power requirements for Sydney's future rail network and the new fleet of airconditioned trains. The work involves construction of new electrical infrastructure across the network as well as the upgrades to substations, section huts, overhead wiring, and feeders.

What work are we doing?

Work through September 2023 will include:

- delivering plant and materials to and from temporary work sites
- trimming and removing vegetation
- identifying utility services
- drilling holes for new power poles and new earthing rods. Temporary covers and fencing will be placed over and around the holes for public safety until the new power poles are installed
- installing new power poles and removing some existing poles
- transferring/restringing conductors (wires)
- restoring locations when our work is finished.

When and where we'll be working

Working hours are **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm, Saturday**. Work may occur anywhere on the feeder route shown on the map on the next page. Expected work areas and dates are shown but may change without notice.

Out of hours work is scheduled from 6pm to 6am the following morning at the following locations:

- **Eldridge Road, Condell Park** between Jellicoe and Mons Streets on **Friday 1 September**
- Between **Bransgrove Road, Revesby** at Albert Street and **Polo Street, Revesby** near Horsley Road on **Thursday 7 September**
- **Polo Street, Revesby** between Iluka Street and Marco Avenue on **Friday 8 September**
- **Albert Street, Revesby** between Milperra Road and Gordon Parker Street on **Wednesday 13 September**
- **Eldridge Road, Condell Park and Bankstown** between Antwerp and Jellicoe Streets on **Thursday 14 September**
- **Polo Street, Revesby** between Horsley Road and Iluka Street on **Friday 15 September**
- **Albert Street, Revesby** between Beaconsfield Street and Bransgrove Road on **Wednesday 20 September**
- **Eldridge Road, Bankstown** between Northam Avenue and Antwerp Street on **Thursday 21 September**
- **Northam Avenue, Bankstown** between Griffith Park and Cambridge Avenue on **Friday 22 September**.

Ausgrid may schedule and notify separately for any power outages. Cancellation of work due to weather may occur without notice.

What will this mean for you?

Partial lane and road closures may be in place close to the work areas near the rail corridor.



Access to properties and traffic movements may be delayed for short periods of time, typically less than 10 minutes. For your safety, please follow the direction of traffic control personnel.

You may notice an increase in construction vehicle movements within and near the rail corridor work areas.

The timing and extent of any power outages are subject to planning by Ausgrid. If any power outage is necessary, Ausgrid will provide notification and we will coordinate with Ausgrid to restore power as soon as it is safe to do so. Please contact Ausgrid on 13 13 88 if you have any questions or concerns in relation to any power outage. We apologise in advance for any inconvenience this work may cause.

Equipment to be used

Plant and equipment to be used include augers, cranes, elevated work platforms, vacuum trucks excavators, street sweeper, service vehicles, delivery vehicles, electrical and hand tools.

Managing our impacts

Transport for NSW is committed to minimising the impact on the community.

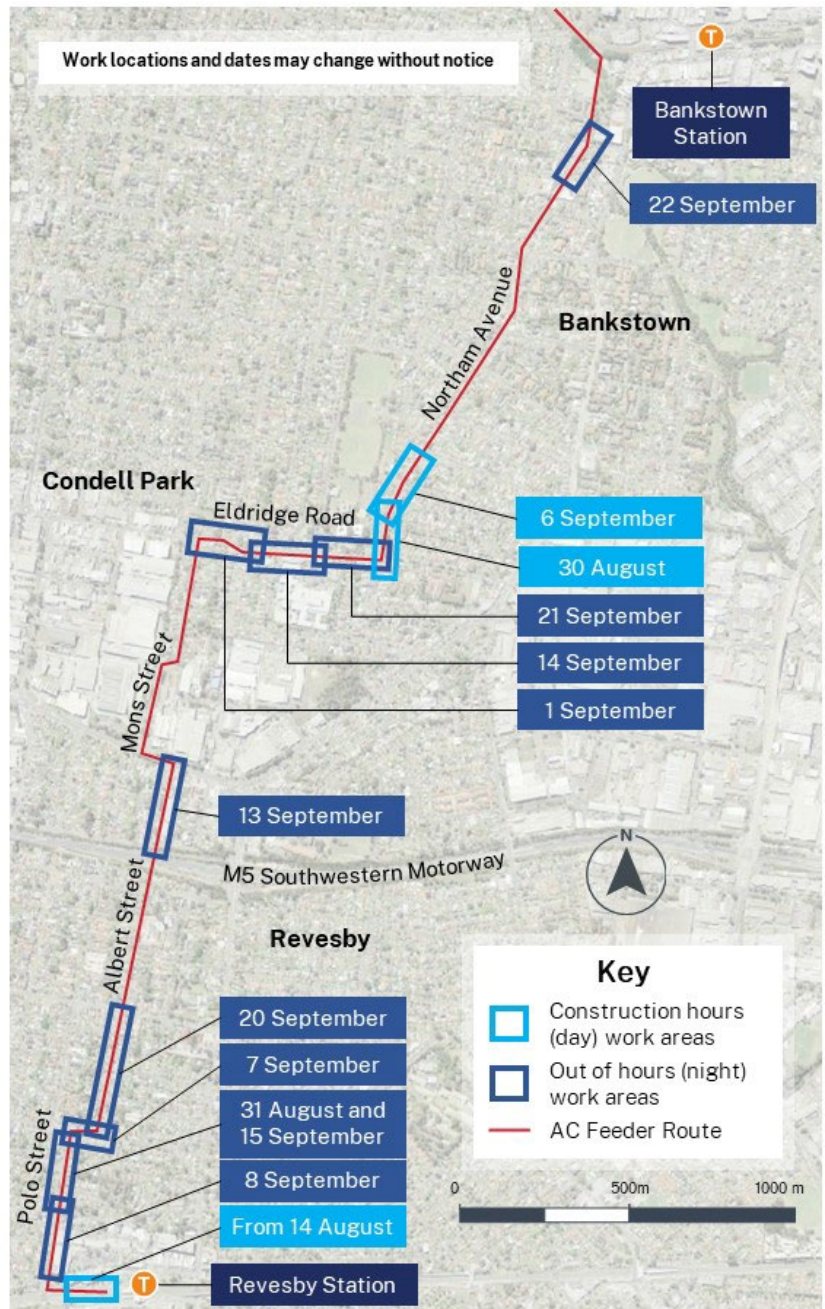
We switch off equipment when it is not being used, place equipment as far away from properties as possible and monitor our work activities to make sure noise levels are being managed effectively. Higher noise-generating work is only expected to occur for short periods.

Revesby Station car park

Work in the **Revesby Station car park** to upgrade underground cable routes will be ongoing through September during construction hours. Sections of the car park will remain closed. Access for residents and businesses will always be maintained. Please

refer to onsite signage for further details. Pavement sawing and rock hammering may be necessary. We apologise for any inconvenience caused while we undertake this essential work.
