



# AC Feeder Upgrade – Sefton, Birrong, Yagoona and Bankstown

## Power Supply Upgrade

October 2023



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Darug and Eora Nations as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

The AC Feeder Upgrade Project is part of the Power Supply Upgrade which is designed to meet expected power requirements for Sydney's future rail network and the new fleet of airconditioned trains. The work involves construction of new electrical infrastructure across the network as well as the upgrades to substations, section huts, overhead wiring and feeders.

### What work are we doing?

Work through October 2023 will include:

- delivering equipment and materials to and from temporary work sites
- finalisation work if required
- restringing of conductors (wires)
- restoring locations when our work is finished.

### Equipment to be used

Plant and equipment expected to be used include augers, excavators, cranes, elevated work platforms, service vehicles, delivery vehicles, electrical and hand tools.

### When and where we'll be working

Working hours are **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday, and 8am to 1pm, Saturday**. Work within working hours may occur anywhere along the feeder route shown on the map on the next page. The feeder route is mostly within the rail corridor.

Work inside the rail corridor is planned for **6am to 6pm, Saturday 21 October and Sunday 22 October 2023**. Work will be in three locations as shown on the map on the following page:

- **Opposite O'Neill Park, Yagoona** between Farnell Road and Nobbs Road
- In the **commuter car park at Yagoona Station**
- Near **Melanie Street bridge, Yagoona**.

### What will this mean for you?

**Closure of the car park at Yagoona Station** will be required for work **6am to 6pm, Saturday 21 October and Sunday 22 October 2023**. On site signage will be provided through October providing further information about the closure.

Transport for NSW is committed to minimising the impact on the community. You may notice an increase in construction vehicle movements within and near the rail corridor work areas. For residents living near the rail corridor, there may be some daytime noise from project work.

On street traffic movements may be delayed for short periods of time, typically less than 5 minutes, for plant deliveries through rail corridor access gates. For your safety, please follow the direction of traffic control personnel.

### Managing our impacts

We switch off equipment when it is not being used, place equipment as far away from properties as possible and monitor our work activities to make sure noise levels are being managed effectively. Higher noise-generating work is only expected to occur for short periods.

We apologise in advance for any inconvenience this essential work may cause.
