



More Trains, More Services Program

Wollongong Stabling Yard and Platform Extension Project

June - July 2020

The More Trains More Services (MTMS) Program is a NSW Government initiative to simplify and modernise Sydney's existing rail network. The Program aims to improve capacity throughout the network, with a view to providing 'turn up and go' services for many customers in the future.

Project update

As part of the More Trains, More Services program, the Wollongong Stabling Yard and Platform Extension project has been approved. Thank you to everyone who provided feedback on the Review of Environmental Factors during consultation undertaken in September last year. Your feedback was considered in the planning approval process. All submissions received were addressed in the Determination Report, which can be downloaded from the project webpage at yoursay.transport.nsw.gov.au/mtms-wollongong

A construction contract has been awarded to *Transport for Tomorrow*, comprising of Laing O'Rourke and KBR who will work in partnership with Transport for NSW to deliver a package of work including the upgrades to be delivered by this project.

Site investigations will start from **Monday 29 June 2020** with main construction work progressing in the coming months. Once construction commences it will take around two years to complete.

Upgrade to be delivered

The Wollongong Stabling Yard and Platform Extension Project will allow additional trains and see eight car trains increased to 10 car trains for peak services on the South Coast.

Upgrade work will include:

- extension of both platforms by approximately nine metres at the southern end
- reconfiguration of the railway tracks between the station and stabling yard
- changes to overhead wiring, underground utilities and signals
- new staff walkways for drivers, cleaners and maintenance crews within the rail corridor
- new fencing and drainage work
- improvements to lighting and closed circuit television systems.

What you will notice

We are continuing to deliver projects across NSW while ensuring the safety of all staff and the community. In line with current Australian Government guidelines around slowing the spread of Coronavirus and social distancing, all work will be carried out at a safe physical distance where possible and necessary hygiene practices will be observed.

Activities being undertaken in June and July include:

- temporary site establishment to the south of the commuter car park off Railway Station Square
- geotechnical and utility investigations within the existing location of stabling yard and tracks
- survey work.

Construction hours

This month, work will be undertaken during standard construction hours, between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday, and 8am and 1pm Saturday.**

Transport for Tomorrow understands construction activities may cause disruption and the on-site team are committed to minimising impacts where possible, including turning off machinery when not in use, directing lighting away from residents and ensuring strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration and dust management are adhered to.
