



DC Feeder Upgrade Project – Lewisham

Power Supply Upgrade

July 2023



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gadigal and Wangal people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is making improvements to electrical infrastructure to meet expected power requirements for Sydney's future rail network and new fleet of air-conditioned trains. As part of this, Transport for NSW is carrying out power supply upgrade work through our DC Feeder Upgrade Project.

What work are we doing?

The DC Feeder Upgrade Project will improve power delivery to the railway across a number of sites on the rail network, including at Lewisham.

In July we will:

- establish a temporary site compound, including hoarding and facilities
- install electrical infrastructure such as cables, overhead wiring and metal fixings inside the rail corridor
- remove vegetation from the embankment adjacent to the substation.

When and where we'll be working

Work will take place inside the rail corridor next to the Lewisham Substation as shown on the map overleaf.

Workers will access the site from Alfred Street, Lewisham and a site compound will be used for storage of equipment and materials, and pre-start work meetings.

Standard construction hours are between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm on Saturdays.**

Out of hours work

Some work will take place outside of standard construction hours from **10pm Friday 14 July through to 2am Monday 17 July.**

This work will take place during scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork periods when no trains will be running. Scheduling work outside of standard construction hours enables us to complete essential work safely.

Temporary parking changes

Parking on Alfred Street will be temporarily unavailable from 3pm Thursday 13 July through to 6pm Sunday 16 July.

This is to enable construction activities during scheduled trackwork periods.

Traffic management will be in place to ensure the safety of the community and workers.

What will this mean for you?

In addition to the temporary parking changes on Alfred Street you may notice:

- workers and vehicles
- noise from machinery and equipment
- traffic controllers on Alfred Street, Lewisham.

Managing our impacts

We understand construction activities may cause disruption for the community.

We'll seek to minimise impacts as much as possible and adhere to strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration and dust management.
