



Changed traffic conditions on the Newell Highway – barrier installation

Transport for NSW is carrying out construction work on the Newell Highway as part of the Newell Highway Upgrade, heavy duty pavement upgrade (Narrabri to Moree) project.

We have included a map to show location of the works.

What work are we doing?

Lead contractor Fulton Hogan is delivering the work on behalf of Transport for NSW. Work will include installing traffic management devices and safety barriers.

When we'll be working

Work will be carried out from **Tuesday 27 June 2023** and is expected to take ten days, weather permitting.

Work hours are between **6.30am** and **6pm Monday to Sunday**.

We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures and up to a 40km/h speed limit will be in place during work hours and will affect travel times.

Motorists should continue to allow up to **15 minutes of additional travel time** when travelling between Narrabri and Moree.

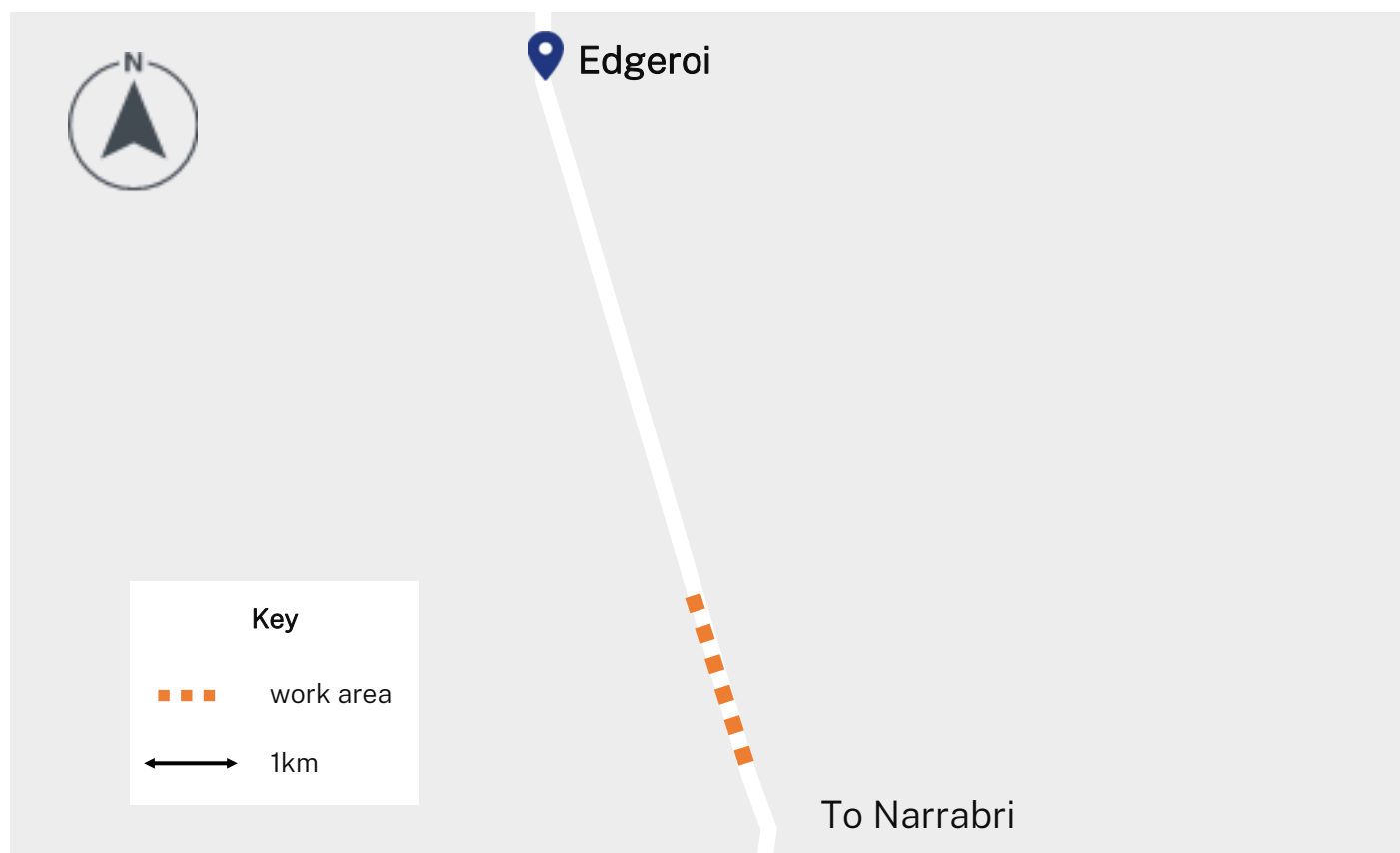
Outside work hours, both lanes will be open at a **reduced roadworks speed limit of 60km/h** until final completion of the installation. Once installation is complete the outside work hours speed limit will be increased to 80 km/hr.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
