## Traffic switch on the Newell Highway, at Bellata from Thursday 9 March

Transport for NSW is carrying out essential construction work on the Newell Highway as part of the Newell Highway Upgrade, heavy duty pavement upgrade (Narrabri to Moree) project.

As part of the construction program in Section 3 of the project, we are preparing to move traffic onto an alternate section of the highway, between Belar Street and Temi Street in Bellata to continue construction of the pavement. We have included a map to show the location of the work.

Traffic will be moved onto the new lanes between **10am** and **2pm** on **Thursday 9 March**, and expect to complete the work in one day, weather permitting.

Lead contractor Fulton Hogan are delivering the works on behalf of Transport for NSW and will be working between **6:30am** and **6pm**. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

### Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures and a 40km/h speed limit will be in place during work hours and may affect travel times. Motorists should allow up to 5 minutes extra travel time during this work.

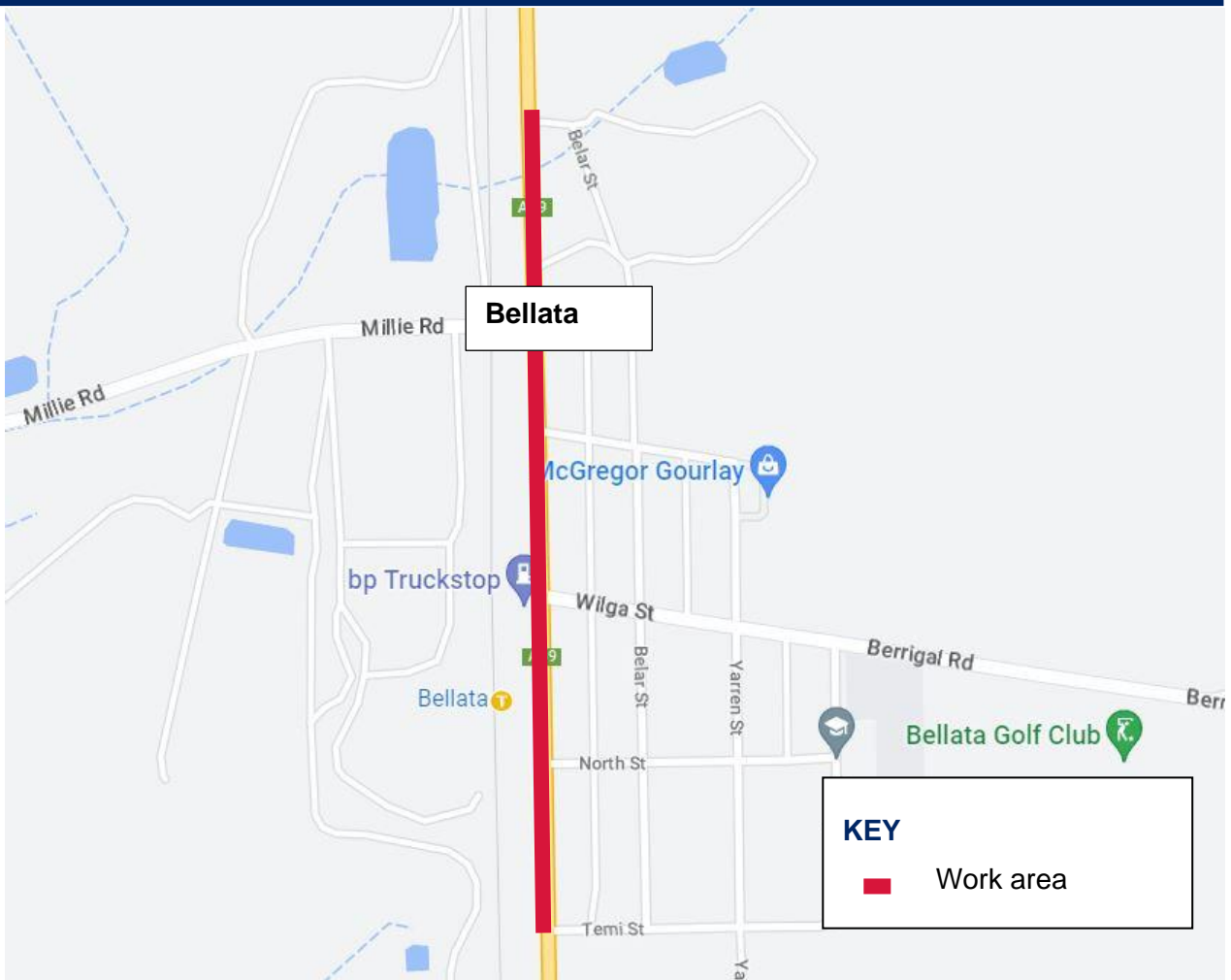
