



Investigation work on The Northern Road and Londonderry Road

December 2022

What we are doing

Transport for NSW will conduct investigations at several locations along The Northern Road between Richmond Road, Bligh Park and Dunheved Road, Cambridge Gardens and Londonderry Road, between the Driftway, Richmond and Cranebrook Road, Cranebrook. This work will help us plan for flood resilience improvement projects as part of the Hawkesbury-Nepean Valley Road Resilience Program.

Investigations will be conducted from **Monday 12 December** to **Friday 28 April 2023**, weather permitting. We will undertake ground survey and geotechnical investigations involving drilling boreholes, test pits, and core drilling to test soil and road conditions. We have included a map overleaf showing the locations of work.

Our work schedule

Geotechnical investigations

Work will commence from **Monday 12 December 2022** and be completed by **Friday 31 March 2023**. We will be on site for **12-night shifts** and **12 day shifts** during that period, weather permitting. For the 12-night shifts, our work hours will be between 7pm and 6am from Sunday to Thursday. We will be working up to five nights a week.

Survey investigations

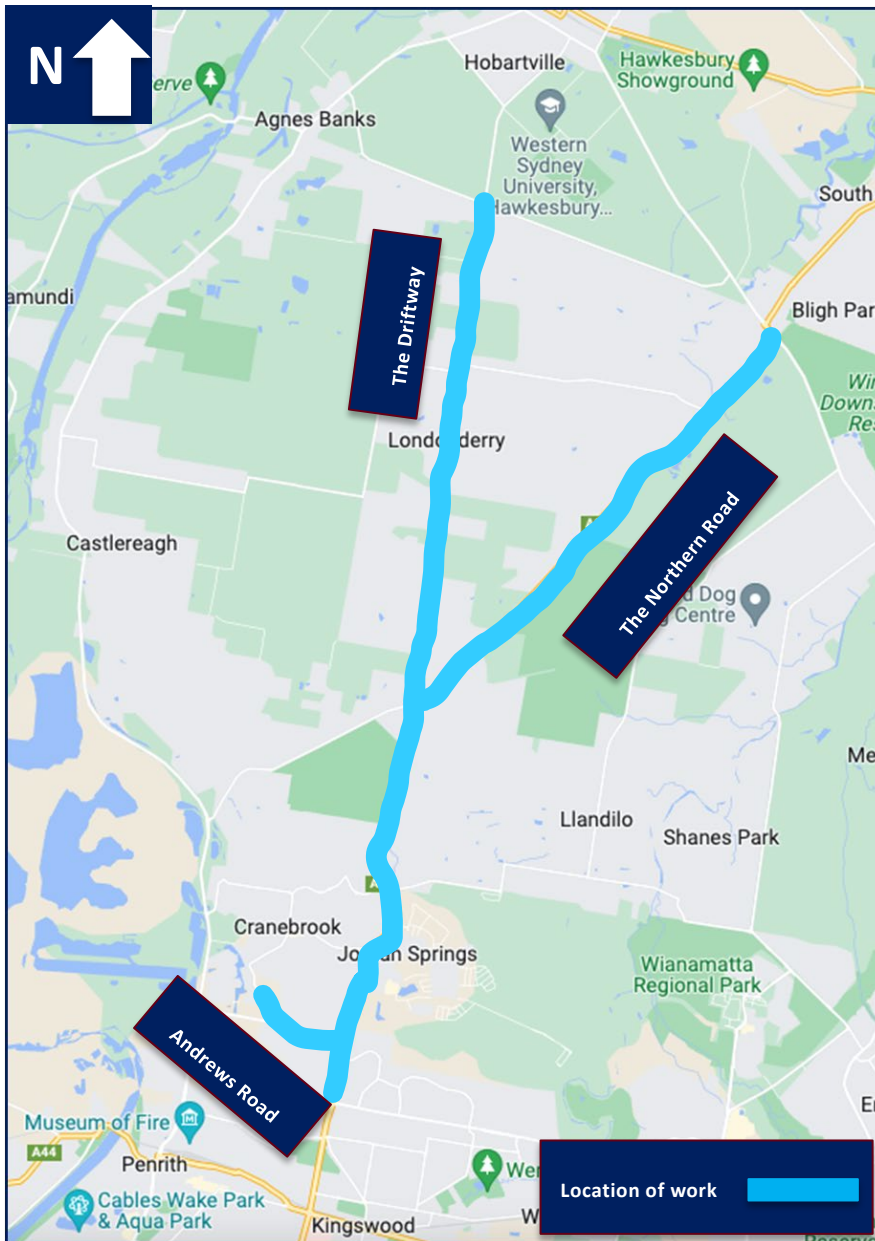
Work will be ongoing at multiple locations from **Monday 12 December 2022** and will be completed by **Friday 28 April 2023**. Work during the day will occur on weekdays between 7am and 6pm and Saturdays between 7am and 2pm. We will not work on public holidays.

No work will be carried out between 24 December 2022 and 2 January 2023.

How the work will affect you

Some of our work needs to be carried out at night to minimise traffic disruption and reduce safety risks to our workers and motorists. We will not work more than five nights in any one week. The road work may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact.

There will be some temporary traffic changes during our work hours to make sure the work zone is safe. Partial lane closures and reduced speed limits may be in place and affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
